
- Parents who want to equip their children (or take this webinar *with their children!*)

## Devotional Moment

As we enter 2026, it is important to remember Lamentations 3:21-23:

**This I recall to my mind,  
Therefore I have hope.  
The LORD's lovingkindnesses indeed never cease,  
For His compassions never fail.  
They are new every morning;  
Great is Your faithfulness.**

If 2025 was a difficult year for you, then you can be encouraged to remember that the Lord's mercies are new every morning. If you experienced afflictions or struggled with wandering (v. 19), it will be important to 'recall to mind' this hope. The Lord's lovingkindness and faithfulness are so incredible that it is easy for us to forget them in the midst of trials, personal failures, and difficulties. Lamentations specifically reminds us to intentionally recall the hope we have in God's great love and compassion (cf. Phil. 4:8)! There are many examples of God's grace, love, and mercy found in Scripture. One often overlooked example is in the book of Jonah. In fact, he says that this was the reason he did not want to go to Nineveh(!) and tells God that

**"I knew that You are a gracious and compassionate God, slow to anger and abundant in lovingkindness, and one who relents concerning calamity" (Jonah 4:2).**

What are some other examples of God's love, grace, and compassion from Scripture?
