

# CMAA—New York State Chapter Student & Mid-Manager Scholarship FY2025 Application Guidelines

## **New York State Chapter**

The New York State Chapter of the Club Management Association of America, Inc. is located in the following defined territories: Western & Central New York, including Monroe, Wayne, Ontario, Yates, Livingston, Allegheny, Cayuga, Cortland, Herkimer, Madison, Oneida, Onondaga, Oswego, Tompkins, Jefferson and Lewis Counties and all WEST thereof plus the Counties of Crawford, Warren and McKean in Northern Pennsylvania, as contemplated in the original Chapter's Charter of 1938.

NYS CMAA supports 3 colleges and their hospitality programs in this area: Niagara University, Buffalo State College & SUNY Delhi. Buffalo State College & Niagara University both have Student CMAA Chapters.

The New York State Chapter of the Club Management Association of America, Inc, is a Not-for-Profit corporation formed for the purpose of promoting and advancing friendly relations between and among persons connected with the management of Clubs.

## Scholarship Award

The NYS Chapter will award one Mid-Manager and one Student scholarship annually, based on the availability of funds and merit of application. In order to help the recipient, meet certification requirements, and prepare them for the CCM exam, the Mid-Manager scholarship will fund \$2,500 to be applied toward registration costs and reimbursable expenses directly related to travel, lodging, etc. for education or events within local or national CMAA. The Student scholarship will fund \$1,000 to be applied to tuition or to attend local or national student conferences within CMAA.

## Who should apply?

Any student within an active CMAA Student Chapter and has had an active employment or internship role within the Club Industry, local or out of state. Any mid-manager with a non-GM or Head of Club Role who is dedicated to attaining the CCM designation. Must be an active member of the NYS CMAA local chapter or a friend of the chapter.

## **Application Requirements**

#### **Student:**

- 1. Complete the application in it's entirety
- 2. Include a letter of recommendation from a NYS CMAA chapter member
- 3. Currently or previously employed by a CMAA affiliated Club, or have completed an internship with a CMAA affiliated Club
- 4. Grade Point Average
- 5. Show attendance at chapter events 6. Write an essay (between 600-1100 words) addressing the following components:
  - Describe in detail your objectives and goals after graduation Your
  - specific interests within the private club management field

#### Mid-Manager:

- 1. Complete the application in it's entirety
- 2. Include a letter of recommendation from your General Manager
- 3. Include a letter of recommendation from a NYS CMAA chapter member
- 4. Enclose a copy of your current resume
- 5. Write an essay (between 600-1100 words) addressing the following components
  - Describe in detail your career objectives and goals
  - The reason you wish to pursue your CCM designation
  - Your specific interests within the private club management field
