The prices contained on this list are for the various services, goods and merchandise which we can provide to our clients. You may choose only those items you desire and we will perform only those services that you request. However, any arrangements you select will include a minimum charge for our staff, services and facilities as there is a basic amount of our time, equipment and expertise which must be devoted to every type of arrangement that we provide.

If legal, cemetery, crematory or funeral home requirements mean that you must purchase any services or items which you may wish to exclude or did not specifically ask for, we will explain the reason why in writing on the funeral purchase agreement/statement we provide you, thus describing the funeral goods and services you selected and which you will be required to acknowledge and sign. This list does not contain the prices or charges for certain items you may ask for us to purchase or arrange for on your behalf, such as cemetery or crematory fees, flowers, newspaper notices, church or clergy charges, and the like. The charges for these items will be listed on the funeral purchase agreement/statement of account and you will be required to acknowledge and sign.

Our prices are based on a thorough analysis of our operating costs and are continually monitored to provide you with the highest standards of quality at a reasonable and affordable price. We invite you to compare and critique our facilities and pricing structure with other funeral homes in the area. In that comparison, we caution you to evaluate things like parking facilities, location, chapel and lounge areas, goods and services relative to the total overall price. BASIC SERVICES OF FUNERAL DIRECTOR AND STAFF \$3,395.00*

Our fee for the basic services of funeral director and staff includes, but is not limited to professional staff to respond to initial request for service; arrangement conference with family and responsible parties; arrangement of funeral; preparation and filing of necessary authorizations and permits; recording vital statistics; preparation and placement of obituary/death notice; and coordination with those providing other portions of the funeral, (e.g., cemetery, crematory, and others as required). Also included in the charge are overhead expenses relative to our facilities such as professional licensing, legal and accounting fees, insurance(s), capital improvements, building and utility expenditures, parking lot and grounds, general maintenance, real estate taxes, equipment, furnishings, recordkeeping, secretarial and administrative expenses and lastly governmental (OSHA/ADA/FTC) compliance.

This fee for our basic services and overhead will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements you select. (This fee is already included in our charges for direct cremations, immediate burials, and forwarding or receiving remains.)

The charge for a direct cremation includes removal of remains, local transportation to crematory, necessary authorizations, and basic services of staff. This charge does not include any cash advanced items, the crematory fee, medical examiner's permit fee to cremate, or the use of facilities and staff for any visitation or funeral/memorial ceremony, public or private, prior to the cremation. If you want to arrange a direct cremation, you must use an alternative receptacle. Alternative receptacles encase the remains and can be composed of materials like fiberboard or composition materials (with or without an outside covering). The receptacles we provide consist of cardboard container material, fiberboard receptacles, and wood veneer caskets.
