You might like to bring your togs and towel, walking pole and a jacket if the weather doesn't look too good. Wear suitable walking shoes.</p> <p>On our way out of Tryphena we'll stop and do the Station Rock Walkway - a short walk to the top with awesome views over Tryphena and Medlands. You might need a walking pole for this walk.</p> <p>From here we can drive to Medlands for a walk along the beach before driving to Claris for morning tea or lunch depending on the time.</p> <p>We can then either head out to the Mermaid Pool or the local Art Gallery or the Milk, Honey and Grain local museum. This museum showcases the fascinating history of Great Barrier's early settlers.</p> <p>Then it's time for a visit to Aotea Brewery for a bit of a beer tasting session before we head to the airport.</p> <p>We need to be at the airport in time by 4pm, an hour before our flight back to Auckland at 5.00pm.</p> <p>We arrive at Auckland Domestic Airport at 5.30pm.</p> | <p>Own cost</p> <p>Transport paid.</p> <p>Flights included</p> |

Gear List: This is not a gear list as such - more just an idea of what you might need/want to bring

Suitable clothes for our exploring walks on Fri and Sun and our Garden Tour on Saturday.
