White Star Trail

Thursday 18th March – Sunday 21st March 2027

While White Star Station has been around for some time, the walking track has only been open to public bookings since last year. Be one of the first and join us on this adventure through the untamed heart of the Coromandel Peninsula.

Over 3 days the 35km trail journeys through native forests, soaring ridge lines, and hidden waterfalls. Our packs will be transported between each accommodation and hearty and delicious meals are provided while on track.

Thursday 18 th Mar	DAY ONE	COST
<p>From 1:00pm</p> <p>5:00pm</p>	<p>We start our road trip from Auckland Airport so if you are flying into Auckland make sure you arrive by lunchtime. Pick ups within Auckland can also be arranged 😊</p> <p>We make our way across the Hauraki Plains, through Thames, stopping in Coromandel Town for an early dinner.</p> <p>We push on to the White Star Farm Cottage just before Colville where a delicious evening snack platter awaits us. Here we can unwind, ease into Coromandel time, and prepare for our walk tomorrow.</p> <p>Accommodation tonight is at the Farm Cottage.</p>	<p>Transport included.</p> <p>Dinner own cost.</p> <p>All-inclusive hiking package included.</p>
Friday 19 th Mar	DAY TWO	COST
<p>8:00am</p> <p>9:30am</p>	<p>Enjoy breakfast together and pack our lunch before starting our first walking day. We just take our day pack with us today with wet weather gear, lunch, water, first aid kit. Our big bags will be transported to the next accommodation.</p> <p>12kms, 5 to 7 hours. The trail climbs steadily through regenerating bush and farmland, winding upward to The White Star—a 400-metre summit with sweeping coastal views and a great spot for lunch. The afternoon takes us south along the ridgeline before descending through meandering trails to the valley floor.</p> <p>Our accommodation tonight is the Eco Bush Cabins - tucked into a side valley and wrapped in native forest.</p> <p>Once we arrive we can relax on the deck with a cold drink or even take the optional detour—a 15-30 minute walk along the Wairore stream to a stunning private waterfall and swimming hole.</p> <p>Pre-dinner snacks and a scrumptious dinner provided.</p>	
Saturday 20 th Mar	DAY THREE	COST
<p>8:00am</p> <p>9:00am</p>	<p>Enjoy another hearty breakfast together and get ready for Day 2 on the trail...</p> <p>13kms, 4 to 8 hours. The trail follows old mining and kauri logging routes through groves of nikau palms before emerging at the central ridgetop and another spectacular lunch stop. From here we traverse the central ridgeline southward, before turning west where the land opens up to epic Hauraki</p>	

	<p>Gulf panoramas. Our final descent is gentle, leading to the Oceanview Retreat and our third night's rest.</p> <p>Settle in, watch the sunset, enjoy dinner and dessert, and then finish off with some stargazing from the spa pool.</p>	
Sunday 21st Mar	DAY FOUR	COST
9:00am	A later start today so time to enjoy an extra coffee with breakfast.	
10:00am	<p>8kms, 2 to 3 hours.</p> <p>The trail takes us past epic rocky bluffs and broad valley views before descending through inland forest, crossing a flowing stream, and emerging into the central valley of White Star Station.</p> <p>From here, it's an easy 3 km stroll home.</p> <p>Back at base, we have the chance to freshen up with a hot shower, before bidding farewell to our White Star hosts.</p>	
1:30pm	We hop back in our van and head back to Auckland (with a quick lunch stop) arriving at Auckland Airport by about 5pm. If flying out of Auckland please ensure your flight departs after 6pm.	<p>Lunch own cost.</p> <p>Flight own cost.</p>
