Attention: Parents and/or Guardians,

It is the responsibility of the Fall River Public Schools to identify any child who is a resident of Fall River between the ages of 3 through 21 who may have a disability, regardless of the severity of the disability. It is also the responsibility of the Fall River Public Schools to evaluate those students to determine if they are eligible for special education or related services under IDEA (Individuals with Disabilities Education Act) or 603 CMR 28 (Massachusetts Special Education Regulations).

The Fall River Public Schools district is committed to identifying children before their third birthday in order to provide early intervention services for three and four year-olds. If you have questions or concerns regarding your child's development and would like to have them screened, please call the Early Childhood office at (508)675-8421 xt 55144.

If you suspect that your child at any age, may need an evaluation to determine eligibility for special education services, you may request an evaluation, at no cost, at your child's school or through our district Special Education Office
