French Onion Soup Casserole

1/4 c butter
5 med vidalia onions, thinly sliced
2 tsp kosher salt
1/2 tsp pepper
3 thyme sprigs
2 flat leaf parsley sprigs
2 bay leaves
1 (16 oz baguette, thinly sliced
1/3 c flour
1/2 c sherry
8 oz Gruyere cheese
1 tsp fresh thyme leaves

Directions

Melt butter in a Dutch oven over medium-low; add onions, salt, pepper, thyme and parsley sprigs, and bay leaves; cook, stirring often, until onions are golden brown, about 1 hour. Remove and discard thyme and parsley sprigs and bay leaves from onion mixture. Add flour, and cook, stirring constantly, 2 minutes. Add broth and sherry; bring to a boil over high. Boil, stirring constantly, until slightly thickened, 2 to 3 minutes. Layer half of the toasted baguette slices in a 13- x 9-inch baking dish. Spoon onion mixture evenly over bread. Top evenly with remaining baguette slices. Sprinkle with cheese; cover with aluminum foil. Bake in preheated oven 30 minutes. Increase heat to broil. Remove foil; broil until cheese is bubbly, about 3 minutes. Sprinkle with thyme leaves.




