Lay Preaching Academy

Purpose: Equip lay members of congregations to preach and lead worship with confidence

The intent is that participants will learn to preach and lead worship with a fuller understanding of our unique ELCA Lutheran framework and a solid grounding in the Bible. To that end, the content will include attention to the following four questions:

- What is a sermon?
- How do we read and understand scripture through a Lutheran lens?
- What is the practical task of creating a sermon?
- Why do we worship as we worship, i.e. what is the shape of worship and what does it all mean?

Course Materials

Handouts provided ahead of time by instructors, as well as two books that participants will be required to purchase. The books are:

- Faithfully attend each session, honoring the commitment of leaders and peers.
- Read assigned material ahead of time to participate fully in discussion and learning during sessions.
- Ask questions without fear of judgment from peers or leaders.
