




Donations are being accepted for the victims of Hurricane Ida. All donations will be sent to Lutheran World Relief.

McKenzie County Food Pantry Needs

Items of food in the Thanksgiving (11-15-22) and Christmas (12-13-22) meal baskets:

CANNED VEGETABLES: Green beans & Corn

CANNED FRUIT: Fruit Cocktail, Pineapple, Peaches

OTHER: Chicken Broth (15, 32 or 48 oz), Stuffing Mix, Instant Potatoes, Peanut Butter (16, 18, 28 or 40 oz), Jelly, Beef Ravioli,

Cream of Mushroom Soup

CEREAL: (box or bag), Instant Oatmeal (6-10 ct/box)

Meat: Turkey Breast, Whole Chicken, Ham

Food that is stocked at the Food Pantry:

CANNED VEGETABLES

Whole Kernel Corn, Green Bean, Sweet Peas, Diced Tomatoes, Carrots, Beets, Cream Style Corn, Potatoes, Mixed Vegetables

CANNED FRUIT

Applesauce, Pears, Peaches, Mandarin Oranges, Fruit Cocktail, Pineapple, (Any kind of fruit cups)

CANNED BEANS

Pork & Beans - 15oz & 28oz, Pinto, Navy, Black, Kidney, Chili Beans... etc.

CANNED SOUP

Tomato, Chicken Noodle, Chicken with Rice, Vegetable Beef, Vegetable, Chicken/Beef Broth, Chili W/Beans, Beef Stew, Chicken Broth, (Any soup will be fine, even cream of Mushroom, Chicken.....)

Spaghetti Noodles, Elbow Macaroni, Rice, Instant Potatoes, Stuffing, Spaghetti Sauce-15oz &24oz, Beef Ravioli (& 4 pack), Mac n' Beef, Spaghetti O's (Rings), Helper Boxes (Hamburger), Boxed Macaroni & Cheese, Ramen Noodles, Beef & Chicken, Spaghetti with Meatballs, Knorr Rice/Pasta Sides

The McKenzie County Food Pantry provides extra food for a holiday meal with their regular food giveaway. Please see the list above for food needed for the holiday boxes and items we keep stocked when available. When you do have food items to donate, they may be dropped off at the McKenzie County Extension Office behind the courthouse (west) in a separate building. If it is a large donation, you may call 701-444-3451 for an arrangement to be made at the food pantry located at First Lutheran Church. Please no expired items. Every item must have a label and a date.
