1. Architectural Review Requests

- Once your portal has been activated, you will submit an architectural review request for **any exterior improvements on your home or Lot.**

2. Maintenance Requests

- You can submit a maintenance request for any general concerns or questions. Once we have reviewed and researched your request, we will respond to you via email through your maintenance request within 24 to 48 hours.

3. Common Ground Maintenance

- TreeStone Properties ensures that the lawn care company maintains all common areas in the community according to the lawn care contract. If you notice any areas that appear to be improperly maintained, we encourage you to submit a maintenance request with pictures and details. This will allow us to have the lawn care company inspect and address the issues as needed.
