Multi-Discipline

Donald & Claire Kramer Foundation Award

Donald and Claire Kramer are offering an award of \$1000 to recognize the contributions of ROBIN SWALES to the cultural life of Regina as a performer, administrator, board member, organizer and supporter in many artistic spheres over more than 40 years. Dr. Swales is an Emeritus Professor of History and a former head of the College of Fine Arts at the University of Regina, a former President of the Regina Music Festival Association and a former Director of Music at Holy Rosary Cathedral where the Foundation established the Swales Organ Scholarships and where distinguished organ recitalists have frequently appeared under his aegis in recent years. The Award will be made annually to the student in all 15 and older age groups who, in the opinion of the adjudicators, is most outstanding in two or more disciplines (in at least two solo classes in each discipline) during the Regina Music Festival.

Regina Central Lions Scholarship Competition

MLT Aikins Scholarships
