Job Description

The Representative works with the FCA Equestrian Georgia Director and Advisory Board to fulfill the FCA Vision, pursue the FCA Mission and live the FCA Values by implementing the ministry plan for the assigned area. In the FCA Equestrian sports environment, the Representative ensures there is a consistent approach to discipleship -- making disciples who make disciples. The Representative is accountable for ensuring that the FCA Equestrian ministry is conducted according to biblical standards and adheres to FCA policies and procedures.

This particular team member will be responsible for helping maintain all current ministry alongside other staff. They will also create and execute growth of ministry into the competitive arenas of the equestrian sport. Including, but not limited to, offering devotions and/or prayer at shows, partnerships with local showing associations, and exploring how to best incorporate faith-based activities with competitive barns and programs.

Other Details:

- Must have a deep desire for all people to hear the Gospel, develop a saving relationship with Jesus, and grow continually in their faith
- Responsible for raising financial support for their staff role. This includes the opportunity to discuss and determine compensation and weekly hours.
- Provide oversight for a segment of the ministry's existing Huddles and actively invest in the growth and development of current volunteers (see: Talent Advancement).
- Identify, recruit, and train new volunteers to establish additional Huddles within targeted barns or communities.
- Assist in planning, organizing, and executing current ministry events, while also exploring opportunities for future events.
- Maintain a consistent presence within the equestrian community—such as at shows or clinics—building relationships and sharing your life with the intention of finding opportunities to present the Gospel.
- The ideal candidate would be:

- Familiar with or actively involved in the equestrian sport
- Available during evenings and weekends
- Possesses a “trailblazer” mindset and is comfortable standing out or pioneering new efforts
- Technologically proficient; comfortable with social media and its potential ministry impact
- Creative and adaptable
- Strong verbal and written communication skills
