Enrollment

Believe it or not, we're already planning for next year's enrollment! At least 141 of our currently enrolled children will transition to kindergarten this fall, which means approximately 86 children may be eligible to return for the next school year.

As of March 20, 2026, House Bill 114 (HB 114) requires all Ohio school districts to admit children to kindergarten only if they are 5 years old on or before the first day of school in their district. Because start dates vary from district to district and may change each year, some of our children could be impacted by this new requirement.

Family Advocates will soon be completing the 2nd Year Enrollment and Transportation Needs forms with all families who are age eligible to return. It's also time to get sibling applications and follow-up on incomplete applications.

We also will be participating at the Tuscarawas County YMCA's event "Healthy Kids Day" on Saturday, April 19 and at the Smart Start Event on Thursday, March 26 at Newcomerstown School.
