The Victim Assistance Coordinator will report to Bishop Hicks and coordinate efforts of pastoral support and outreach to assist in the healing process.

The Victim Assistance Coordinator can also assist in making a report to civil authorities.

REPORTANDO ABUSO SEXUAL

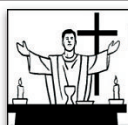

A MESSAGE FROM...

UN MENSAJE DE...

Rev. Jesus Oliveros

The disciples going to Emmaus experienced a moment from darkness to light, from blindness to revelation, from distraction to recognition. In a certain way, they lived a catechesis and an experience of faith in the new presence of Jesus. "When their eyes got opened, they recognized him." The road; the conversation; the explanation of the Scripture; the breaking, blessing and sharing of bread were the elements of **Christophany** which means a manifestation of Jesus after his ascension.

Therefore, the road to Emmaus is an encounter with the Risen One. As a result, it was a passage from death to life, from fear to freedom, from isolation to return to the community.

For this reason, our journey to Emmaus today means looking deeply into our reality, recognizing our disappointments and our doubts, and not settling into skepticism but, instead, letting ourselves be accompanied by the one who always has the Word of Light.

The Gospel tells us that the disciples' eyes were clouded. But the Lord, with patience, walking with them, explained the Scriptures to them. The Word and the breaking, blessing and sharing of bread are the acts of love that allow the recognition of the Risen One.

Brothers and sisters, May the Lord give us the capacity to have an encounter with the word of the risen one who guides us.

May the Lord give us the capacity to recognize in our disoriented heart His resurrection so that we feel the joy of the Gospel and the passion of life.

En cierto modo, vivieron una catequesis y una experiencia de fe en la nueva presencia de Jesús. "Cuando se les abrieron los ojos, lo reconocieron". El camino; la conversación; la explicación de las Escrituras; el partir, bendecir y compartir el pan eran los elementos de la Cristofanía, es decir, una manifestación de Jesús después de su ascensión.

El Evangelio nos dice que los ojos de los discípulos estaban nublados. Pero el Señor, con paciencia, caminando con ellos, les explicó las Escrituras. La Palabra y el partir, bendecir y compartir el pan son los actos de amor que permiten el reconocimiento del Resucitado.

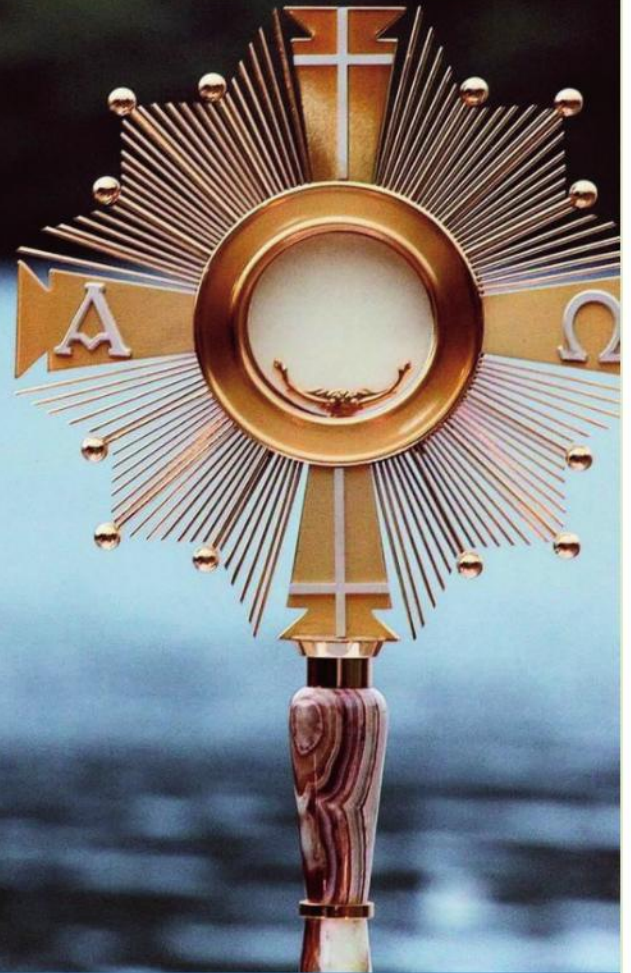
Hermanos y hermanas, que el Señor nos dé la capacidad de tener un encuentro con la Palabra del Resucitado que nos guía.

At the end of the National Eucharistic Congress last year, Bishop Cozzens announced there would be a National Eucharistic Pilgrimage from Indianapolis to Los Angeles in 2025.

Upon being asked, Bishop Hicks gratefully accepted the honor for the Diocese of Joliet to be the first Diocese on the National Eucharistic Pilgrimage St. Katharine Drexel Route.

The Diocese of Joliet will receive the Eucharist from the Pilgrims and Chaplains coming from a Mass in Indianapolis, IN on Sunday, May 18 and we will present the Eucharist to the Diocese of Peoria at St. Patrick Parish in Seneca, IL on Monday May 19.
