

The Ascension of the Lord Coming or Going?

One way of looking at the Ascension is that Jesus can do much more for us in his glory than he could while on earth. How does this work? It happens in two steps. First, he sends the Holy Spirit to the disciples. Second, the disciples become his witnesses to all the nations. So let's look at the first step.

The Gospel of John that is read on the Vigil of Pentecost says that "there was . . . no Spirit yet, because Jesus had not yet been glorified" (John 7:39). Obviously the Spirit is co-eternal with the Father and the Son, so John is trying to get our attention. He means that we could not experience the gifts of the Spirit until Jesus had died and risen from the dead. While Jesus walked the earth, he chose to be limited in time and space, so that a few people could get to know and love him. But after his resurrection, he could be more effective by sending his Spirit to all believers. Because he is ascended into glory, he can live in all of us. Just as the power of the Holy Spirit caused Mary to be the mother of Jesus, so that same power enables Jesus to live in us. And that leads to the second step.

Before his death, Jesus began to collect a group of followers. Some got to know him more deeply and became disciples. The rest of the followers were merely curious or attracted by stories of miracles he had performed. They did not have the faith and courage to bring others to Jesus; some only stayed with him a short time. But after his ascension the disciples began to experience Jesus in each other. They could not help but be excited about that and spread that excitement to others. From the time of Jesus' ascension to our own time, people have boldly proclaimed the gospel. So Jesus' ascension actually makes him present to more people, not fewer. May we all experience that presence in the Spirit, seeing Jesus in ourselves and others.

La Ascensión del Señor ¿De ida o venida?

Una manera de ver la Ascensión es que Jesús puede hacer mucho más por nosotros en su gloria de lo que pudo mientras estuvo en la tierra. ¿Cómo funciona esto? Sucede en dos pasos. Primero, envía el Espíritu Santo a los discípulos. Segundo, los discípulos se convierten en sus testigos para todas las naciones. Así que veamos el primer paso.

El Evangelio de Juan que se lee en la Vigilia de Pentecostés dice que "pues aún no había venido el Espíritu, porque Jesús no había sido glorificado" (Juan 7,39). Obviamente el Espíritu es coeterno con el Padre y el Hijo, por lo que Juan está tratando de llamar nuestra atención. Quiere decir que no podríamos experimentar los dones del Espíritu hasta que Jesús muriera y resucitara de entre los muertos. Mientras Jesús caminaba por la tierra, eligió estar limitado en el tiempo y el espacio, para que unas cuantas personas pudieran llegar a conocerlo y amarlo. Pero después de su resurrección, pudo ser más eficaz enviando su Espíritu a todos los creyentes. Porque ascendió a la gloria, puede vivir en todos nosotros. Así como el poder del Espíritu Santo hizo que María fuera la madre de Jesús, ese mismo poder permite que Jesús viva dentro de nosotros. Y eso nos lleva al segundo paso.

Antes de su muerte, Jesús comenzó a reunir un grupo de seguidores. Algunos llegaron a conocerlo más profundamente y se convirtieron en discípulos. El resto de los seguidores simplemente tenían curiosidad o se sentían atraídos por las historias de los milagros que había realizado. No tenían la fe y el valor para llevar a otros a Jesús; algunos solo se quedaron con él un corto tiempo. Pero después de su ascensión, los discípulos comenzaron a experimentar a Jesús en los demás. Se emocionaron mucho por eso y difundieron ese entusiasmo a los demás. Desde el momento de la ascensión de Jesús hasta el día de hoy, la gente ha proclamado el evangelio con valentía. Por eso, la ascensión de Jesús lo hace presente a más personas, no a menos. Que todos experimentemos esa presencia del Espíritu, viendo a Jesús en nosotros mismos y en los demás.


