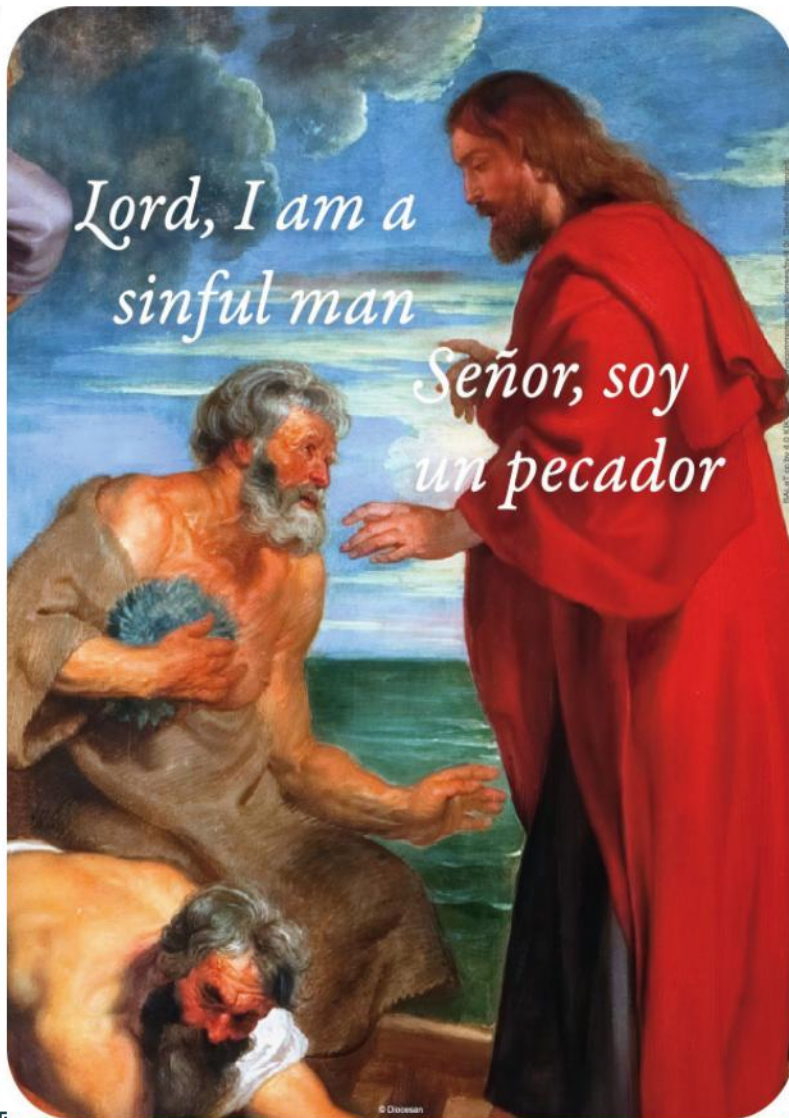

REPORTING SEXUAL ABUSE

The Diocese of Joliet Victim Assistance Coordinator is available to help victims /survivors of child sexual abuse by a cleric, employee or volunteer of the Catholic Church.

The Victim Assistance Coordinator will report to Bishop Hicks and coordinate efforts of pastoral support and outreach to assist in the healing process.

The Victim Assistance Coordinator can also assist in making a report to civil authorities.

La Oficina del Coordinador de Asistencia Para Víctimas informará al obispo Hicks de lo sucedido y coordinará esfuerzos de apoyo pastoral y de divulgación para ayudar a las víctimas en el proceso de sanación.

El Coordinador de Asistencia Para Víctimas también puede ayudarle a hacer un reporte a las autoridades civiles.

Saints Peter and Paul, Apostles Key to the City

When an important person visits a city, sometimes the mayor presents the key to the city as a sign of welcome; or a key may be presented to a citizen who has given outstanding service to the community. In today's Gospel, Jesus gives Simon both the keys to the kingdom of heaven and a new name, Peter. This is more than just a symbolic honor bestowed by a mayor. Jesus is actually giving both a blessing and a responsibility.

The blessing is that Peter recognized Jesus as the Son of God. It was a blessing because Peter did this, not by his own cleverness or the help of other disciples, but with faith, a gift from God the Father. Even today, people are blessed with this kind of faith. An atheist who has heard of Jesus but regards him as just another holy man may receive the faith to see that Jesus is the Son of God. A person who withdraws from others and only cares about himself may find the faith to see Jesus in those around him. A sick person may see that Jesus is with her in her suffering and begin to have hope. The faith that sees Jesus in others is the rock on which Jesus builds his church. It is also the "crown of righteousness" that St. Paul says belongs to all who long to see Jesus (2 Timothy 4:18).

The responsibility comes in the binding and loosing. One meaning of this is the power that Jesus gives his church to forgive sins. Jesus forgave many sinners, sometimes even before they asked. He knew they wanted forgiveness in their hearts, though they may not have dared to ask for it. He even forgave those who crucified him (Luke 23:34). So those who follow Jesus have that same obligation to forgive others. If we forgive those who hurt us, they may come to see God's love in us and know that God forgives them, too. On the other hand, if we refuse to forgive, we might push someone away from seeking God's forgiveness. That doesn't mean we are responsible for how others react to us. But why pass up an opportunity to show God's love by forgiving someone? All Christians pray in the Lord's Prayer that we may be forgiven as we forgive others. Let us use the keys of the kingdom to open the doors of God's love.



Santos Pedro y Pablo, Apóstoles

Cuando una persona importante visita una ciudad, a veces el alcalde le presenta la llave de la ciudad en señal de bienvenida; o a veces se entrega una llave a un ciudadano que haya brindado un servicio ejemplar a la comunidad. En el Evangelio de hoy, Jesús le entrega a Simón las llaves del reino de los cielos y le da un nuevo nombre, Pedro. Esto es más que un honor simbólico otorgado por un alcalde. Jesús le está dando tanto una bendición como una responsabilidad.

La bendición es que Pedro reconoció a Jesús como el Hijo de Dios. Fue una bendición porque Pedro lo hizo, no por su propia inteligencia o la ayuda de otros discípulos, sino con la fe, un don de Dios Padre. Incluso hoy en día, las personas son bendecidas con este tipo de fe. Un ateo que haya oído hablar de Jesús pero lo considera otro hombre santo puede recibir la fe y reconocer a Jesús como el Hijo de Dios. Una persona que se aparta de los demás y sólo se preocupa por sí mismo puede encontrar la fe para ver a Jesús en los que le rodean. Una persona enferma puede ver que Jesús está con ella en su sufrimiento y empezar a tener esperanza. La fe que ve a Jesús en los demás es la roca sobre la cual Jesús edifica su Iglesia. También es la "corona de justicia" que San Pablo dice que pertenece a todos los que anhelan ver a Jesús (2 Timoteo 4,18).

La responsabilidad viene en el atar y desatar. Un significado de esto es el poder que Jesús le da a su Iglesia para perdonar los pecados. Jesús perdonó a muchos pecadores, a veces incluso antes de que se lo pidieran. Sabía que querían perdón en sus corazones, aunque es posible que no se hayan atrevido a pedirlo. Incluso perdonó a los que lo crucificaron (Lucas 23,34). Los que siguen a Jesús tienen la misma obligación de perdonar a los demás. Si perdonamos a quienes nos lastiman, es posible que lleguen a ver el amor de Dios en nosotros y sepan que Dios también los va a perdonar. Por otro lado, si nos negamos a perdonar, podríamos alejar a alguien de buscar el perdón de Dios. Eso no significa que seamos responsables de cómo reaccionan los demás hacia nosotros. Pero, ¿por qué dejar pasar la oportunidad de mostrar el amor de Dios al perdonar a alguien? Todos los cristianos rezamos en el Padrenuestro para que seamos perdonados como perdonamos a los demás. Utilicemos las llaves del reino para abrir las puertas del amor de Dios.
