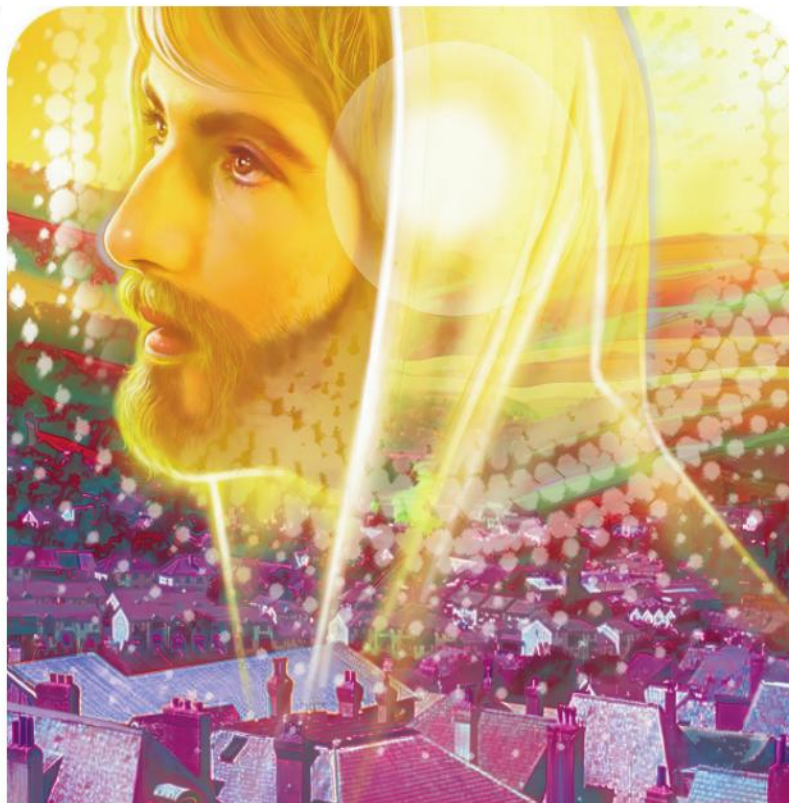

*Seventeenth Sunday in Ordinary Time*  
*Be Careful What You Ask For*

Jesus talks about praying for whatever we need with faith and confidence, but he ends by asking, "How much more will the Father . . . give the Holy Spirit to those who ask him?" (Luke 11:13). Is he saying there are limits to what we can ask for?

"Be careful what you ask for," the saying warns. Just because we want something doesn't mean it will be good for us. Remember the Indiana Jones movies? The artifact that the bad guys were seeking usually turned out to be lethal. But if we have enough faith to pray for something, we probably would not pray for anything evil. So what is Jesus really saying? He is giving us two lessons about prayer.

First, he assures us that God does hear our prayers and answers them. Many people take "ask and you shall receive" so literally that they expect God to do their bidding no matter what they want. Prayers, however, are not a magical ritual that somehow forces God to do our will. God is free to do what is best for us, free to answer some prayers with a no when what we seek is against God's will. So maybe our first prayer should be to ask God to show us what we really need.

That leads us to the second lesson: prayer changes us, not God. If we truly pray as Jesus prayed, we would ask for what we need, adding, "Not as I will, but as you will" (Matthew 26:39). If we pray humbly and are open to what God wills for us, we will begin to see that what we really need most is actually God. It's not easy to change our minds about what we want or need. To change our desires from selfish to holy takes a lot of power, the power of the Holy Spirit. Jesus was raised from the dead by that power and we will be, too (Romans 8:11). Mary conceived by the power of the Spirit (Matthew 1:18). The bread and wine of the Eucharist become the Body and Blood of Christ by the Spirit's power. So when Jesus promises that the Father will give the Spirit to us for the asking, the Spirit is both the source of and the answer to our prayers. Let us ask the Spirit to empower us to desire and pray for what we really need.

*Decimoséptimo Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario*  
*Ten cuidado con lo que pides*

Jesús habla de orar por todo lo que necesitamos con fe y confianza, pero termina preguntando: "¿cuánto más el Padre celestial dará el Espíritu Santo a quienes se lo pidan?" (Lucas 11,13). ¿Está diciendo que hay límites a lo que podemos pedir?

"Ten cuidado con lo que pides", advierte el dicho. El hecho de que queramos algo no significa que sea bueno para nosotros. ¿Recuerdas las películas de Indiana Jones? El artefacto que buscaban los malos generalmente resultaba letal. Pero si tenemos suficiente fe para orar por algo, probablemente no oraríamos por nada malo. Entonces, ¿qué está diciendo Jesús? Nos está dando dos lecciones sobre la oración.

Primero, nos asegura que Dios escucha nuestras oraciones y las responde. Muchas personas toman el "pidan y se les dará" tan literalmente que esperan que Dios haga lo que les piden sin importar lo que quieran. Las oraciones, sin embargo, no son un ritual mágico que de alguna manera obliga a Dios a hacer nuestra voluntad. Dios es libre de hacer lo que es mejor para nosotros, libre de responder con un no a algunas oraciones cuando lo que buscamos va en contra de la voluntad de Dios. Así que tal vez nuestra primera oración debería ser pedirle a Dios que nos muestre lo que realmente necesitamos.

Eso nos lleva a la segunda lección: la oración nos cambia a nosotros, no a Dios. Si oramos verdaderamente como Jesús oró, pediríamos lo que necesitamos, añadiendo: "No según mi voluntad sino la tuya" (Mateo 26,39). Si oramos con humildad y estamos abiertos a la voluntad de Dios para nosotros, comenzaremos a ver que lo que más necesitamos es a Dios. No es fácil cambiar de opinión sobre lo que queremos o necesitamos. Cambiar nuestros deseos de egoístas a santos requiere mucho poder, el poder del Espíritu Santo. Jesús fue resucitado de entre los muertos por ese poder y nosotros también lo seremos (Romanos 8,11). María concibió por el poder del Espíritu (Mateo 1,18). El pan y el vino de la Eucaristía se convierten en el Cuerpo y la Sangre de Cristo por el poder del Espíritu. Por eso, cuando Jesús promete que el Padre nos dará el Espíritu si se lo pedimos, el Espíritu es a la vez la fuente y la respuesta a nuestras oraciones. Pidámosle al Espíritu que nos dé fuerzas para desear y orar por lo que realmente necesitamos.

## These things you have revealed to simple people.

Once again, in one of the Masses, I reflected on the gospel of Mt 11:25-27 in which Jesus tells us about reveling his greatness to simple people. God is always God, and in His eternal **wisdom and love**, He has His own way of reveling for his children. As proof, in today, gospel, Jesus tells us that God the Father has revealed Himself to **simple people** and not to **the wise and learned**. That is to say, God always reveals His mystery to every person who has an open heart, to every person who is willing to seek the truth in God.

But Jesus Himself, in some way, **expands** this horizon of Divine revelation.

These words of Jesus, in today's gospel, have a connection to the gospel when He says that He is the light of the world. That's why, whoever is with Him will not walk in darkness. Therefore, the best way is to stay with Him who is willing to reveal to us not only who His Father is, but also all His mystery of love.

Jesus came into the world, not to show us the truths of mathematics, physics, biology, natural sciences, etc. Instead, He reveals the truths that help us live with **meaning and hope** here on earth before we face death.

Indeed, no one better than He knows the secrets of human life.

So, for this reason, Brothers and Sisters, let us ask the Lord to give us a heart willing to be open to His revelations, to receive His mystery, and to live out His truths.

## Estas cosas las has revelado a la gente sencilla.

Una vez más, en una de las Misas, reflexioné sobre el evangelio de Mt 11:25-27 en el que Jesús nos habla de revelar su grandeza a la gente sencilla. Dios siempre es Dios, y en Su sabiduría **y amor** eternos, Él tiene Su propia manera de deleitarse con sus hijos. Como prueba, en el evangelio de hoy, Jesús nos dice que Dios Padre se ha revelado a **la gente sencilla** y no a **los sabios y doctos**. Es decir, Dios siempre revela su misterio a cada persona que tiene un corazón abierto, a cada persona que está dispuesta a buscar la verdad en Dios.

Pero Jesús mismo, de alguna manera, **amplía** este horizonte de revelación divina.

Estas palabras de Jesús, en el evangelio de hoy, tienen una conexión con el evangelio cuando dice que Él es la luz del mundo. Por eso, el que está con Él no andará en tinieblas. Por lo tanto, la mejor manera es permanecer con Aquel que está dispuesto a revelarnos no solo quién es su Padre, sino también todo su misterio de amor.

Jesús vino al mundo, no para mostrarnos las verdades de las matemáticas, la física, la biología, las ciencias naturales, etc. En cambio, Él revela las verdades que nos ayudan a vivir con **significado y esperanza** aquí en la tierra antes de enfrentar la muerte.

De hecho, nadie mejor que Él conoce los secretos de la vida humana.

Por eso, hermanos, pidámosle al Señor que nos dé un corazón dispuesto a abrirnos a sus revelaciones, a recibir su misterio y a vivir sus verdades.
