If your child has been selected to try our mini/petite/junior competition class it means they have shown amazing initiative, leadership and potential in their classes this year! Congratulations!

- **What is competition?**
 - Competition is a performance opportunity Studio A chooses to partake in. It gives our students additional chances to dance on stage for an audience, provides professional feedback for our students, and allows them to build team bonds and an understanding of the dance world at a young age.
- **What are the commitments?**
 - The commitments are as follows.
 - Stricter attendance policy - students must only have 3 absences throughout the season. Absences may be made up in an additional class.
 - 3-4 weekends of competition. Dates range from March-June.
 - Practicing at home! Competition students have higher expectations when it comes to their classes.
- **What are the financial commitments?**
 - Prices remain at \$65.00 per month for each class
 - Costume prices go up to \$120.00 per costume
 - Each competition is about:
 - \$50-\$60 per group dance per competition.
 - \$50 per family admin fee per competition.
 - Please remember we do 3-4 competitions.
- **Additional Info:**
 - We do not expect mini/petites/juniors to travel out of state
 - All competitions are local to Long Island
 - Competitions are mandatory and cannot be skipped once making this commitment! Skipping a competition may result in removal from the team.
 - We require no additional classes to be on our mini team
 - We require one technique class per week to be on our Petite/Junior teams
 - Petite/Juniors can opt to take Lyrical and Jazz or just one!
