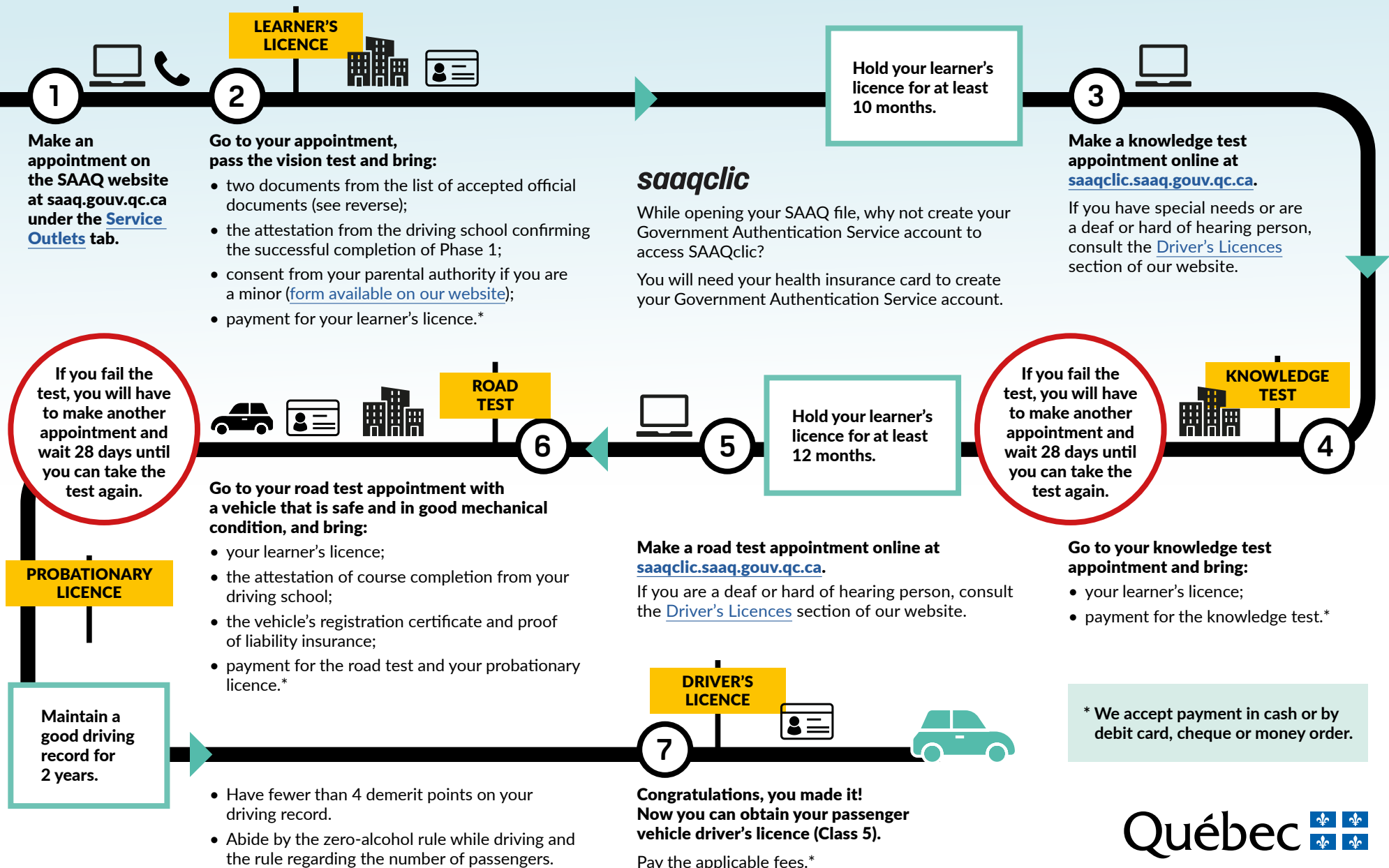

After completing the first four modules of Phase 1 of your driving course and passing the knowledge test given by your driving school (Module 5), follow the steps below.

Requesting accommodations for the SAAQ knowledge test

1 Making an appointment for a knowledge test with accommodations

Call 1-800-361-7620.

- Press 2 to choose the option for making or modifying an appointment.
- Then press 2 again to choose the knowledge or road test option.
- Stay on the line to speak to a client service agent.
- Tell the agent what you need (reading aid, quiet environment, etc.).

2 Preparing for the test

- Study with people close to you (your friends, family, etc.).
- Seek support from community organizations.

4 Continuing your driver training after the knowledge test

You passed?

- Make a road test appointment using [SAAQclik](#) or by calling 1-800-361-7620.

You failed?

- Ask an SAAQ employee to explain the test questions that you did not answer correctly.
- Make an appointment to retake the test.

3 Maximizing your chance of success

- Have a friend go to your appointment with you to help you with registering for the test and understanding the explanations given prior to the test.
- Ask for help with using the computer.
- Ask for paper and a pencil so you can take notes.
- Bring a paper dictionary that does not contain illustrations or notes.
- Request to take the test in Spanish, Mandarin or Arabic, where applicable.

Accepted official documents to open an SAAQ file

(one official photo ID document is mandatory)

If you were born in Canada, provide one of the following documents:

- the original copy of the birth certificate issued by the Directeur de l'état civil du Québec after January 1, 1994, or by the government body responsible for vital statistics in another Canadian jurisdiction (in the case of Ontario, the accepted documents are the short form birth certificate or the original certified copy of birth registration issued by the Office of the Registrar General of Ontario)
- Canadian citizenship certificate
- Canadian passport
- Canadian Armed Forces identity card
- Certificate of Indian Status

If you were not born in Canada, provide one of the following documents:

- Canadian citizenship certificate
- Canadian passport
- Canadian Armed Forces identity card
- Other proof of known legal presence in Canada
- Permanent resident card

The other document may be one of the following, regardless of where you were born:

- health insurance card
- driver's licence from Québec or another jurisdiction
