To help our dynamic local students cover the costs of pursuing higher education, the Chamber will offer two \$ 1,000 scholarships to graduating seniors. The Chamber of Commerce is now accepting applications for this annual scholarship.

To be considered, the applicant must meet the following criteria:

- The student must reside within the Waterloo Community School District #5 or attend Gibault Catholic High School.
- The student must be a senior this year and plan to enter an accredited college, university, community college, or vocational school in the fall of this year.
- Submit a completed application, including a written response to the essay question.
- Submit a current transcript indicating performance, honors, and class rank.
- Demonstrate involvement in community service and volunteerism, work experience, and school activities.
- Demonstrate character and personality – maturity, motivation, moral character, and leadership skills.

Your application will be graded based on the following: Work Experience, Community Service, School Participation and Activities, Written Statements, Essay, and GPA.

All completed applications are due by 3:00 p.m. on Monday, April 6, 2026.

Applications received after the deadline will not be considered. The scholarship winners will be announced at a Chamber of Commerce membership meeting. The Chamber of Commerce Executive Director will notify the winners.
