### Events / Community Involvement

- PrideFest Booth
  - In September 2025, members set up a booth at Pridefest to talk about MADWomen and to help others to register to vote or help them to check their voter registration status.
- Adopt a Classroom Project
  - Members chose 2 teachers to select items needed for their classrooms, and purchased and delivered them all to the teacher's classrooms.
- Winter Community Project
  - In December 2025, MADWomen created bags containing personal care items, hats, and gloves and gave them to the Jackson Police Department to hand out to the people in the community that needed them.
- In January 2026, MADWomen held a Retreat for its members to help reinforce our mission and continue to focus on voter registration and voter education.
- A whopping, 7 members of the MADWomen, are running for election in various positions in Madison County.

### Partnership w/ Indivisible Jackson

- Indivisible Jackson is led by many of our MADWomen, and has continued to be very active.
- MADW members attend protests nearly every Saturday in downtown Jackson (from 12 – 2pm), including the “No Kings 3” protest, that had around 400 protestors. We worked closely with local police to ensure safety of all attendees.
