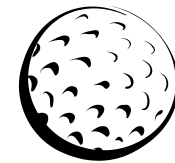

### FCA Golf Challenge Goals

1. 18 Golf Teams (72 Golfers)
2. Generate \$72,000 or more
3. Each Golfer raises \$1,000 or more

It is expected that each golfer would raise no less than a \$500 minimum.

This event is designed to provide a stable financial foundation for this ministry so that it can focus on fulfilling the vision and mission.

## FCA Golf Challenge Explained

### How does this Fundraiser Work?

Unlike a traditional golf fundraiser, this golf event is **NOT** a “pay to play” tournament.

Each golfer's goal is to raise \$1,000 or more and this is usually accomplished when the golfer reaches out to those whom they know and to tell them “What” they are doing and “Why” they are doing it. Our records have shown that if a golfer makes 50 contacts (via letter provided, phone or email), then they generally will raise over \$1,000. In addition, you also are communicating to them the importance of the FCA ministry in reaching out to our schools and community. Some businesses or individuals will write a sponsorship check to get them to the goals listed and that is encouraged as well. This event is as much a “Friendraiser” as it is a fundraiser, as many “Investors” look forward to giving each and every year.

Each golfer will receive a PLAYER PACKET that will include a PLAYER HANDBOOK with all the items needed for this event.

### FCA Golf Captains

The FCA Golf Captain is the key to this event as they are the point person for connecting with others to form a team of 4 who are committed to raising funds for FCA outlined above. We will get materials to the FCA Golf Captain to help them in recruiting their team.

In order to thank the golfer who participates, there are individual prize incentives for those reaching the \$1,500 and \$3,000 levels. There will be tournament prizes as well for golf play.

## Ways to Participate

### How Can I Be Involved?

**1. Be a Team Captain-** Contact the FCA office and obtain the information about serving as a Golf Captain. The main responsibility is to recruit 3 other golfers who will raise funds in the way explained earlier in this brochure & attend the Captains Meeting. As the captain, you are the point person for your team.

**2. Be a Player-** You may participate individually and we will assign you to a team that is not full. Contact the FCA office to obtain all the information.

**3. Be a Fundraiser-** Even if you don't play golf, you can still participate in the fundraising by connecting with others.

### **4. Be a Sponsor-**
