

## Nomination Form

The Retirement Village Residents' Council is an independent body representing the collective interests of retirement village residents, and a place where their concerns can be addressed, ideas can be shared, and decisions are made. It plays a vital role in providing stakeholders, including the Retirement Villages Association, and Government, with guidance on policy matters affecting the retirement village sector. The Council is funded by the RVA, but is entirely independent of it.

The Council is seeking residents who take an interest in policy matters, understand the sector, can reflect their village residents' views impartially, and have mana in their village community.

Nominees are asked to provide a short bio about their background, current activities and role, if any, in their village (e.g. Resident Committee Chair, etc.)

The Council Chair will select up to 15 residents to join the Council. She will try and ensure a broad representation that characterises the diversity of residents in retirement villages as far as possible, including gender, age, ethnicity, disability, background and geographic regions.

There is no cost to the individual residents (other than their time) or to their villages. Council members attend up to a meeting a month. The costs of attending meetings and the like, including for travel and accommodation are paid.

All nominations must be made by a residents' committee or two village residents.
