Staffordshire Bull Terrier Care Essentials

Training & Socialisation: Responsive to reward-based training. Start early with socialisation to encourage good manners and confidence.

Exercise: At least 1–1.5 hours daily. Enjoys walks, tug-of-war, and playtime with the family.

Grooming: Weekly brushing and occasional baths. Clean ears, brush teeth regularly, and keep nails trimmed.

Health: Prone to hip dysplasia, skin allergies, and cataracts. Regular vet check-ups are important.

Diet: High-quality dog food with controlled portions. Adults: 2 meals/day. Avoid overfeeding.

Family Suitability: Excellent with kids when raised with them. Loyal and affectionate, thrives as part of the family.
