Required for: Salmon or steelhead fishing in the Columbia River

✓ Pro tip: Buy in March to get 13 months of fishing!

- Screenshot your license on your phone
- Save a backup in your email
- No need to worry about wet or torn paper!

NOT LONGE TENTION

- Carry your license Must have it while fishing
- Sign it Invalid without your signature
- Check regulations Some areas have special rules
- Catch record card Required for salmon/steelhead

Q: Can I buy a license as a gift?

Yes! Perfect for birthdays or holidays. Purchase online and print/email to recipient.

Q: What if I lose my license?

Replacements are free online at fishhunt.dfw.wa.gov (just log into your account)

Q: Do I need a license for catch-and-release?

Yes, a license is required for all fishing activities

Q: Can I use my license in Oregon or Idaho?

X No, but special Columbia River endorsements work for boundary waters
