Key Features

Who Can Enroll

- All part-time faculty and staff and their eligible dependents.
- Eligible dependents include child(ren) under age 26, spouse, and registered domestic partner. Please note that you must enroll yourself in order to enroll dependents.

When Can You Enroll

- Open Enrollment: Your opportunity to enroll yourself and/or your eligible dependents for the plan year, July 1, 2025 June 30, 2026. After Open Enrollment closes, you can only make changes if you experience a Qualifying Life Event (QLE).
- Qualfiying Life Event (QLE): If you decide to make changes outside of Open
 Enrollment due to a QLE, such as marriage, divorce, birth/adoption, or loss/gain of
 other coverage, you must notify askhr@nu.edu within 30 days of the event.
