The PWOSO Scholarship amount will be **\$1,000.00 per student**. 2 scholarships will be awarded each year.

CRITERIA

- **Must** be a member of a PWOSO Government Agency or related to a member.
- **Must** be at least a high school senior.
- **Must** be a current Ohio Resident
- **Must** attend a college, technical college, or trade school within the United States
- **Must** maintain full-time status.
- **Must** have a high school GPA of 2.5 or higher.
