Disabled bay consultation

We had mixed feedback about the new disabled bay in the top car park in April and carried out a consultation process to allow residents to give their views to help us decide the fairest course of action. We can confirm that we received a higher number of responses asking to retain the bay as a disabled bay and not to reintroduce a drop-off bay. Therefore, the permanent disabled bay will remain. Thank you to those who took part in this consultation process.

Fire Safety Advice Front Entrance Doors

<u>Do not</u> wedge open your front entrance door. This is a fire door and must be kept closed for your own safety and the safety of others.

Escape Routes

Always keep clear of obstructions. <u>Do not</u> place door mats outside your front door. These can cause slips, trips and falls.

Evacuation Procedure

If there is a fire, the corridor alarm will sound throughout your block to alert all residents. If it is safe to do so, please evacuate the building immediately using the nearest exit and wait in the adjacent car park.

Portable Heaters

Please let us know if you have a portable heater belonging to TDHA. We need these returned to carry out necessary electrical testing. Kindly contact a member of staff to arrange collection. Many thanks for your cooperation.

Gardening

Many of you will know our in-house gardener, Mark Blinko. He has recently undergone a knee operation and is recovering well at home. As such, Tom and Jim will be taking on extra gardening duties over the summer and into the Autumn. They will be allocating Tuesdays to concentrate on the gardens at Anstey Court and working on the other sites throughout the week.

Openreach Full Fibre Installation

Openreach has begun installing full fibre broadband at Pearce Court and Summersbee Court, offering faster and more reliable internet by replacing older copper systems with fibre-optic cables. This is part of a nationwide initiative to connect 25 million homes and businesses by 2026. These two schemes are the first to receive the upgrade, with more sites planned.

Summer Spaces

We're making improvements to our outdoor spaces for residents to enjoy over the summer. A new bench has been added at Croft Court, and two new benches have been placed in the garden at Playford Court. A new parasol base has been ordered for Anstey Court, and the honeysuckle around the pergola is beginning to grow, providing natural shade for the years ahead. At Pearce Court, the quad gardens have been tidied and the furniture re-stained, creating a shady and pleasant green space for all to enjoy.
