# Shelby County Chamber of Commerce & Industry Growth Assistance Program (GAP) Revolving Loan Fund Program Summary

The Shelby County Chamber of Commerce and Industry (SCCCI) Growth Assistance Program (GAP) Revolving Loan Fund provides supplemental financing to small and medium-sized businesses located in, or to be located in Shelby County, Iowa. Eligible projects must either create or retain jobs.

Program funds may be used for most aspects of start-up or expansion projects, and, in some cases, may include needed working capital. Funds cannot be used to refinance existing debt or subsidize payments on existing debt.

The primary consideration for financial participation with GAP is the creation and retention of jobs. To qualify for loan assistance, a minimum of three (3) full-time equivalent (FTE) jobs is required. These jobs must be either newly created jobs or jobs to be retained and must be maintained during the length of any loan assistance and cannot come at the expense, or in lieu of, other jobs that the borrower is currently providing.

Because the Program is funded with a combination of local, state, and federal funds, borrowers must comply with all local, state, and federal requirements. The application form was designed to adhere to state financial assistance programs and may be easily amended to apply for state financial assistance.

This year, Crest Services proudly celebrates its **20th anniversary in the Harlan community**. Since opening its first residential program here in 2006–2007, Crest Services has continued to grow, evolve, and strengthen its roots in Shelby County. What began as a small program serving individuals on the **ID Waiver** has expanded over the years to include supports for those on the **Brain Injury (BI) Waiver** and **Habilitation (HAB) Waiver**, ensuring a broad spectrum of individuals can access the stable, community-based services they need.

At the heart of Crest Services is its focus on the **HCBS person-centered model**, which emphasizes choice, autonomy, and meaningful community involvement. Staff work closely with each individual to help them define and reach their personal goals, whether that's learning new skills, building relationships, finding local activities to enjoy, or becoming more independent in everyday life.

Today, Crest Services operates in **six Iowa communities**, including Des Moines, Chariton, Mason City, Cedar Rapids, Ottumwa, and of course, **Harlan**. Additionally, Crest continues to provide services throughout **southern Minnesota**. Each location is anchored by teams who are trained in areas such as brain injury supports, mental health, de-escalation, PBS, trauma-informed care, and more, ensuring safe, supportive environments where individuals can thrive.

As Crest Services marks two decades in Harlan, the team extends heartfelt appreciation to the community, local partners, case managers, and families who have welcomed and supported their mission over the years. The organization looks forward to many more years of partnership, growth, and service in Shelby County and beyond.
