

GOD'S WORD IN ACTION GAMO HIGHLANDS, ETHIOPIA

High in the hills of Southern Ethiopia, something beautiful is happening. The sound of Scripture is echoing through villages where faith has been passed down for generations through spoken word alone. The Gamo people—nearly 1.9 million strong—are rich in oral tradition, yet many cannot read, and printed Bibles in Amharic often felt distant and difficult to understand. The hunger for God was there... but understanding was out of reach.

Everything changed in 2017, when Davar completed the full audio Bible in the Gamo language. In 2025, through a partnership, Talking Bibles were placed directly into the hands of believers across these mountain communities.

Now, God's Word is being heard in Gamo—bringing the Gospel clearly in the heart language of the people and transforming lives. **On the next page are just a few of the powerful testimonies we've received:**

EVANGELIST ZACHAIUS AND FEKADU

FAITH FOUND ON THE VILLAGE ROAD

*"I was walking along a village road when I heard Zachaius, a local evangelist, playing the Gamo Talking Bible. As I approached him, **something lit up in my heart**. He stopped walking and waited until I reached him. I stood there and began to listen. I heard that Jesus saves from the devil."*

I stayed and listened with Zachaius for some time. When I went home, I shared everything with my family. The next morning, I went to church and accepted Christ. My whole life changed. I felt peace—real peace—and now I tell others about that same peace.

In the book of Acts, the prison guard asked Paul, 'What must I do to be saved?' Paul answered, 'Believe in Christ, and you and your family will be saved.'

*That promise stays in my heart. Just as the guard was saved, **I believe I am saved too.**"*

"I received a Gamo Talking Bible and took it home. I started to share it with my family and neighbors.

Through listening, my mom has found hope. She said, 'If Jesus is really like this, I will believe in Him.' So this Talking Bible really works.

SALVATION IN THE SEWING SHOP

"I run a sewing shop. It is a great way to share the Word of God with customers. When I started playing the Gamo Talking Bible, people became very interested and would stay for a long time to listen.

There are young kids who also come and listen. I encourage them to bring their friends, and when they invite someone new, I give them a piece of candy.

The elders also come to listen regularly. They ask many questions. It is difficult to work during this time, but I enjoy sharing with them. When I was behind in my work, I used to come very early to get some sewing completed. However, when people saw me there early, they begged me to play the Talking Bible for them.

I consider it a ministry and will continue to let people listen. Over ten people have decided to follow Jesus, and many are finding hope in Christ." 



PADMA AND NEIGHBOR

FROM GRIEF TO HOPE: HOW PADMA FOUND LIFE IN GOD'S WORD

Padma's life was filled with loss and heartache. Twenty years ago, her second-born son, Subrahmanyam, died tragically in a fight. Her village blamed her for his violent behavior, and she felt abandoned—not only by people, but by the gods she had once trusted. For years, Padma struggled with hopelessness, believing that no person or god could truly help her.

Then, a neighbor shared the story of Jesus. Padma was cautious but listened. Soon after, her first-born son, Srinivas, fell seriously ill with a heart condition. Desperate, Padma prayed with him to this new God. Miraculously, Srinivas was healed. It was the first time she experienced a God who answered prayers, and Padma knew they had to follow Him.

As she and Srinivas began attending church and praying regularly, blessings started to follow. Srinivas found better work, and doors that had been closed for years opened before them. Even amid opposition from her husband, who tried to discourage her faith, **Padma found joy and peace** in her new life in Christ.

Padma never learned to read, so she memorized Scripture through church teachings and songs. Two years ago, her pastor gave her a Talking Bible. Now, she listens to God's Word daily—learning new passages, correcting herself, and speaking more peacefully with others. Through this small device, God continues to transform her heart and life.
