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GP Chronic Condition Management Plan (GPCCMP)

What is GPCCMP?

A GPCCMP is intended to help you work with your GP to look after your health. It is designed to help patients with chronic or long-term medical conditions receive structured, coordinated care.

Any condition that lasts longer than 6 months may be eligible, and there is no age restriction on eligibility.

Why Is This Important?

A GPCCMP is designed to:

- Involve you in managing your own health
- Coordinate your care
- Prevent complications and improve long term wellbeing
- Ensure everyone involved in your care is informed

It also allows access to Medicare-subsidised allied health services (if clinically appropriate).

Allied Health Access

If your GP refers you under your plan, you may be eligible for:

- Up to 5 Medicare-rebated allied health visits per calendar year

Examples include:

- Physiotherapy
- Dietetics
- Podiatry
- Exercise physiology

When Is the Plan Reviewed?

The plan can be reviewed every 3-6 months.

How to Prepare for Your Appointment

Bring:

- A list of current medications
- Recent test results (if done elsewhere)
- Information about other specialists you see
- Any questions or goals you want to discuss
