**Japanese & Giant Knotweed** – Looks like bamboo, can grow up to 12ft tall, large heart shaped leaves, tiny white flowers that form in the leaf axils



**Garlic Mustard** – Plant that smells like garlic when it is crushed, small white flower that is present in late April through early June



**Wild Parsnip** – Plant with a yellow umbrella shaped flower head



**Swallow-wort** – Twining perennial vine. Small, star-shaped flowers are pale pink to reddish brown. Seed pods are milkweed-like, with fluffy seeds spread by wind



**Tree-of-Heaven** – Tree that can grow up to 70ft tall, has smooth, spotted and pale gray bark, leaves smell like peanut butter when crushed, produces clusters of seeds in June



**Bristly Locust** – Shrub that has small round leaflets, stems covered in thick red bristles



**Oriental Bittersweet** – Aggressive vine, red berries with a yellow outer skin



**Phragmites** – A tall wetland grass, grows very dense, up to 13ft tall, has large, purple seed
