Japanese & Giant Knotweed – Looks like bamboo, can grow up to 12ft tall, large heart shaped leaves, tiny white flowers that form in the leaf axils



<u>Garlic Mustard</u> – Plant that smells like garlic when it is crushed, small white flower that is present in late April through early June



<u>Wild Parsnip</u> — Plant with a yellow umbrella shaped flower head



<u>Swallow-wort</u> — Twining perennial vine. Small, starshaped flowers are pale pink to reddish brown. Seed pods are milkweed-like, with fluffy seeds spread by wind



<u>Tree-of-Heaven</u> – Tree that can grow up to 70ft tall, has smooth, spotted and pale gray bark, leaves smell like peanut butter when crushed, produces clusters of seeds in June



<u>Bristly Locust</u> – Shrub that has small round leaflets, stems covered in thick red bristles



<u>Oriental Bittersweet</u> – Aggressive vine, red berries with a yellow outer skin



<u>Phragmites</u> – A tall wetland grass, grows very dense, up to 13ft tall, has large, purple seed
