

2022 APPLICATION FOR ACADEMIC & SERVICE SCHOLARSHIP

Application Due Date

- Must be postmarked by March 31, 2022.
- Late or incomplete applications will not be considered.

Qualifications and Eligibility

All applicants must fit the following criteria:

- High school senior graduating in the current academic year.
- Enrolled for fall of the upcoming academic year as a full time student in an accredited college, university, community college or trade school (must have applied to the school by the date of the scholarship application).
- Minimum GPA of 3.3.
- Currently resides in the 95118, 95120 or 95123 zip codes.

Requirements for Application

Each applicant must complete and submit the following:

- Application form.
- School Activities form.
- Community Activities form.
- Signed Certification form.
- Two letters of recommendation.
- A sealed official copy of your high school transcript, including fall classes of the current academic year.
- A personal essay.

Each applicant must agree to the following:

- Agrees to allow the AVWC to use their names and photographs for publicity
- Agrees to attend the Almaden Valley Women's Club Scholarship and Logo Award Presentation ceremony.
- If the applicant becomes a recipient of an AVWC scholarship, they must show proof of expenditure of the scholarship amount towards university/college fees by October 1st. Failure to show proof will require the AVWC scholarship funds to be returned to AVWC.

- 12 pt font or larger
- Margins a minimum of 1" for right and left and 0.5" for top and bottom.
