This is the mid-year check point, which concentrates on sight reading, scales and etudes. **Complete both** pages of this form and bring it with you to the Mid-Year Exam.

If completing Level 1 or higher, you will need to perform an etude for the mid-year exam as well as the technical requirements (Scales, Chords and Arpeggios) listed; the etude need not be memorized and cannot be used as a final exam piece. Please consult the syllabus for the Royal Conservatory of Music Certificate Program as a guide for repertoire selection – you are welcome to use other pieces, but the level of difficulty must be the same or higher. Please consult Joan Forsyth, Piano Department Chair, if in doubt! Junior and Senior diploma candidates should perform one memorized piece and should submit their programs at this time. Prep A and Prep B students do not have to play an "etude", just an additional piece at the same level. It need not be memorized.
