For the 2024 *Link Up* program, the RI Philharmonic is thrilled to partner with Carnegie Hall and present **The Orchestra Sings**. This exciting concert will teach your students about the orchestra as they literally become "members of the orchestra."

Link Up is a music education program that connects your classroom with the concert hall. It is designed for students in grades 3-5, but may also be appropriate for older or younger audiences, depending on their current level of musical interest. No prior music experience is required.

The RI Philharmonic supplies each participating school with quality recorders and digital resources for students and a Curriculum Guide for the teacher. The program culminates in a joyful interactive concert at The VETS in Providence where students celebrate their learning by playing with the RI Philharmonic.

Once you register your school for the concert experience and a professional development session, you will receive access to **The Orchestra Sings**, a curriculum that explores rhythmic patterns, sweeping contours and expressive qualities of great melodies. More importantly, we'll learn about the melody's role in bringing people together through song.

Your Students will perform with the Rhode Island Philharmonic Orchestra! Repertoire highlights include movements from:

- Dvořák New World Symphony
- Beethoven Symphony No. 9
- Stravinsky The Firebird

The culminating Link Up Concerts will be held on Wednesday May 22, Thursday May 23 and Friday May 24, 2024 at 9:45am & 11:30am. A wonderful way to celebrate learning in the music classroom, tickets are just \$5/student & \$5/chaperone for this joyful and highly engaging program.
