## **PARENT CODE OF CONDUCT**

We expect for all parents to abide by a Code of Conduct which includes the provisions which follow. If any of these rules are broken, The Westchester Untouchables organization board and committee shall have the authority to impose a penalty.

### ***Parents shall:***

- 1.** Be prohibited from verbally attacking, harassing, or challenging the coaching staff's strategy and authority during practice or games. If they have a need to speak out about a matter on the field, we ask that you pull the coaches aside after practice or games to discuss the matter with the intent to help and not to cause discord. If parents do not handle matters as stated in the prior sentence and the offense continues during practice and games, the organization's officials will ask you to leave the field. If coaches do not handle it through this process, then he/she will be asked to leave the field of play and may forfeit their position as a coach within the organization. If you persist even after we asked you to leave the field of play, we will then have the authority to remove you.
- 2.** Accept decisions of league officials (including referees, coaches and board members) as being fair and to the best ability of said officials.
- 3.** Not criticize an opposing team, its players, coaches, or fans by word of mouth or by gesture.
- 4.** Refrain from using physical or verbal abuse or profane language at any time at the game, practice field, or other WESTCHESTER UNTOUCHABLES functions.
- 5.** Abstain from being under the influence of or in possession of and/or drinking alcoholic beverages and the possession or use of any illegal substance on both the game and practice fields. Drinking or selling alcoholic beverages, using or selling illegal substances or coming to any WESTCHESTER UNTOUCHABLES sanctioned event intoxicated or under the influence of illegal substances is grounds for immediate dismissal and possible lifetime suspension. (This could result in legal action by the organization)
- 6. *Not be allowed on the sidelines during a game.*** (Staff with ID's only)
- 7.** Not interfere/interrupt the coaching staff before, during or AFTER games or at practice.
- 8.** Parents are prohibited from the practice field during practice. You must watch practice from the outskirts of the entire field unless you are a coach you're not allowed on the field. Parents are not allowed to enter the playing field even after the game has ended, you must wait until the coach brings the team off of the field of play first before you come around the team. In addition, no parent is allowed to take their child from the team until the Coaching Staff is officially done addressing the team. This goes for practices and games.
- 9.** Abusive, violent, or sexual contact with any child, staff member, fan, referee or any participating person will result in immediate dismissal. (This could result in legal action by the organization)
- 10.** Sexual or vulgar conduct or language is prohibited and shall not be tolerated. This could also be grounds for immediate dismissal
- 11.** Not express complaints about coaches in stands or to coaches in front of or around the children (i.e. right after a game or practice).
- 12.** Refrain from using Language that is considered offensive from a racial, ethnic, religious or gender perspective is prohibited and will not be tolerated.
- 13.** Theft and/or misappropriation of funds, equipment, or any other WESTCHESTER UNTOUCHABLES paraphernalia or the personal belongings of WESTCHESTER UNTOUCHABLES

members and fans is grounds for immediate dismissal from the organization. (This could result in legal action taken by the organization.) Anyone who violates the code of conduct risks the future participation of his/her children, as well as their own, in the program. Depending on the severity of the incident the board of directors may decide to ban future participation in the program for up to three years.

### **WESTCHESTER UNTOUCHABLES Disciplinary Actions to the Rules of Conduct**

Violations will be brought to the WESTCHESTER UNTOUCHABLES Board of Governors for review and the determination of disciplinary action. If disciplinary action is deemed necessary, the Board shall convene a hearing in which all affected parties shall be given ample opportunity to testify concerning their witnessing or involvement in the incident. Upon hearing all witnesses and evidence, the Board shall review the same and render a judgment, including any disciplinary action necessary. Because of the infinite range of potential violations and severity of the same,

it shall be the responsibility of the Board to determine suitable disciplinary actions for the offense.

#### **Examples of potential violations include:**

##### ***Warning Letter:***

The warning letter will be issued for the first time offenders of the rules of conduct. A letter will be issued per violation. The letter will explain the violation and when it occurred and who the violation was against. Anytime a violation occurs after the warning letter is issued, you will be placed into the second phase of the disciplinary action. The Warning Letter will come from the President or Vice President of the organization as an official document. This official document (on WESTCHESTER UNTOUCHABLES letterhead - to be official), will be tendered to the alleged offending individuals with copies available to the Board of Governors only. General Members will not be privy to this document unless otherwise authorized by the alleged offending parties.

##### ***Practice/Game Suspension:***

Practice and/or game suspension will be issued to those who violate any of the rules of conduct repeatedly. A practice and/or game suspension can be coupled with a warning letter if the violation warrants this particular action.

##### ***Season Suspension:***

Season suspension will be handed out when there's an accumulation of violations or an offense is severe enough that the Board of Governors feel it is necessary to place the offender on a season suspension.

##### ***Lifetime Suspension:***

A lifetime suspension will be issued if the violator has gone through the chain of suspensions or the violation is severe enough that the previous code of conduct penalties would be tabled in favor of a lifetime suspension. ***Additionally, the WESTCHESTER UNTOUCHABLES may pursue legal action as appropriate based on the nature and severity of the Code of Conduct violations. Should any legal action need to be taken against any party, the WESTCHESTER UNTOUCHABLES organization will look to retrieve the legal fees incurred, from the opposing party, in full, and without prejudice.***

**Parent's Agree that:**

*I hereby pledge to provide positive support, care, and encouragement for my child participating in the WESTCHESTER UNTOUCHABLES program by following this Parents Code of Conduct.*

*I will encourage good sportsmanship by demonstrating positive support for all players, coaches, and officials at every game, practice or other events.*

*I will place the emotional and physical wellbeing of my child ahead of my personal desire to win.*

*I will insist that my child play in a safe and healthy environment.*

*I will require that's my child's coach be trained in the responsibilities of being a youth sports coach and that the coach upholds the coaches code of ethics.*

*I will support coaches and officials working with my child, in order to encourage a positive and enjoyable experience for all.*

*I will demand a sports environment for my child that is free from drugs, tobacco and alcohol and will refrain from their use at all events.*

*I will remember that the game is for youth -not adults.*

*I will do my very best to make youth sports fun for my child.*

*I will ask my child to treat other players, coaches, fans and officials with respect regardless of race, sex, creed or ability.*

*I will help my child enjoy the youth sports experience by doing whatever I can, such as being a respectful fan, assisting with coaching, or volunteering in one activity during the season.*

*I will not:* Criticize officials (including referees, coaches and board members), direct anger, verbal abuse or profane language toward them, or otherwise subvert their authority.

*Undermine, in work or deed, the authority of the coach or administration. Intrude onto the field, stand on the sideline, or yell from the bleachers at games or practice at or to the coaches, referees or administration.*

CONDUCT OF ALL PLAYERS- All players are guaranteed plays in each Jamboree, Regular Season or Playoff game. Numbers of mandatory plays are determined by the number of players listed on the MPR. Everything beyond mandatory plays that must be earned in the opinion of the coaching staff whose decisions are final.

### **Athlete's Code of Conduct:**

***I will:*** emphasis the ideals of sportsmanship, ethical conduct and fair play. Show courtesy to my opponents and officials. Recognize athletic contests are serious educational endeavors. Give complete allegiance to my coaches who are the instructional authority for my team. Discourage fans, fellow players and parents from undercutting my coach's authority.

***I will not:*** Use profanity or talk "trash" before, during or after any game. Use drugs, alcohol, or tobacco. Criticize my teammates. Act in any way that may incite spectators.

***I will not:*** Criticize the officials, use profane language toward them, or otherwise subvert their authority. I will not undermine their work or deed. I will not intrude onto the field, stand on the sideline, or yell from the bleachers at or to the coaches, referees or administration.
