C.O.P.S. Co-Workers Weekend is held in partnership with Survivors of Blue Suicide.

Who is invited to attend the weekend?

C.O.P.S. Co-Workers Weekend is planned for surviving co-workers (21 years or older) of law enforcement officers who died in the line of duty (causes of death include: Accidental, Felonious, Natural/Illness, and Suicide). Other relatives and friends are not eligible to attend.

How will the weekend benefit me?

C.O.P.S. Co-Workers Weekend will give you the opportunity to attend group and individual sessions specially designed for your needs, participate in fun outdoor activities, receive support from peers who understand, and have a good time in a casual setting that is removed from the stresses of every day life.

You will spend the weekend addressing your needs and unwinding in the evenings with other law enforcement officers who have been through a similar experience. It is our goal for you to leave the weekend feeling relaxed with a continuing support system and sense of personal growth.

Where is the weekend located?

We will be staying at the YMCA of the Rockies in Estes Park, CO. This is located 90 minutes outside of Denver.

How do I get to the weekend?

If you are flying, You should plan to arrive at Denver Airport (DEN) between 9:00 a.m. and 3:30 p.m. on Friday, October 2. You will be met by a C.O.P.S. representative at the airport and transported to the YMCA of the Rockies by bus. You will be transported back to the Denver Airport on Monday, October 5, by 11:00 a.m. Please be sure your return flight is AFTER 12:00 p.m. to allow time for check-in and security checks.

If you are driving, You will need to arrive at the YMCA of the Rockies by 6:00 p.m. on Friday, October 2, and stay through breakfast on Monday, October 5. **Meals and activities are planned; no late arrivals or early departures please.**

What is the cost of the weekend?

Your only expenses will be the cost of your airfare to and from Denver Airport or mileage to and from the YMCA of the Rockies. If you are flying, C.O.P.S. will provide busing from the Denver Airport upon arrival and busing back to the Denver Airport upon departure. All lodging, meals, and activities are provided at no cost. If you fail to cancel your attendance or do not show up for the program, you may be subject to a participation fee for the following year's program.
