Who is invited to attend the weekend?

C.O.P.S. Co-Workers for Couples Weekend is planned for surviving co-workers and their spouse/domestic partner* (21 years or older) of law enforcement officers who died in the line of duty, as determined by C.O.P.S. criteria. Other relatives and friends are not eligible to attend.

*Domestic partner is defined as a long-term committed legal or interpersonal relationship between two individuals who live together and share a common domestic life (i.e. not just a boyfriend/girlfriend).

How will the weekend benefit me?

C.O.P.S. Co-Workers for Couples Weekend will give couples the opportunity to discuss the challenges they experience as part of the law enforcement culture in a relaxed setting to gain a better understanding of what each side is going through. Losing a co-worker that is part of your blue family is devastating but officers still struggle with identifying as a survivor.



Additionally, significant others of surviving co-workers struggle with how to support their loved one, as well as the fear that something will happen to them. These concerns will be addressed through group and individual sessions with the goal to strengthen your relationship. You will spend the weekend receiving support from peers who understand, participating in fun outdoor activities, and addressing your needs away from the stresses of every day life.

Where is the weekend located?

We will be staying at Epworth By The Sea in St. Simons Island, GA. This is located 60 minutes outside of Jacksonville, FL.

How do I get to the weekend?

If you are flying, You should plan to arrive at the Jacksonville Airport (JAX) between 9:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. on Friday, April 10. You will be transported back to the Jacksonville Airport on Monday, April 13 by 11:00 a.m. Please be sure your return flight is AFTER 12:00 p.m. to allow time for check-in and security checks.

If you are driving, you will need to arrive at Epworth By The Sea by 5:00 p.m. on Friday, April 10, and stay through breakfast on Monday, April 13. **Meals and activities are planned; no late arrivals or early departures please.**



What is the cost of the weekend?

Your only expenses will be the cost of your airfare to and from the Jacksonville Airport or mileage to and from Epworth By The Sea. If you are flying, C.O.P.S. will provide busing from the Jacksonville Airport upon arrival and busing back to the Jacksonville Airport upon departure. All lodging, meals, and activities are provided at no cost. If you fail to cancel your attendance or do not show up for the program, you may be subject to a participation fee for the following year's program.


