
July 24-28, 2023 // Epworth By The Sea - St. Simons Island, GA

Who is invited to attend the camp?

C.O.P.S. Young Adults Camp is planned for surviving children and siblings (15-20 years of age) of law enforcement officers who died in the line of duty, as determined by C.O.P.S. criteria. Other relatives and friends are not eligible to attend.

How will the camp benefit me?

C.O.P.S. Young Adults Camp will give surviving children and siblings the opportunity to be surrounded by peers who understand their loss. This camp will be a mixture of fun camp-like activities and a structured adult program, allowing surviving children and siblings to grow into young adults.





We will be staying at Epworth By The Sea in St. Simons Island, GA. Participants will be roomed in cabins with others their age with supervision from adult mentors. Activities will be put on by law enforcement agencies in the surrounding area on and off site. Transportation will be provided to all activity locations.



How do I get to the camp?

If you are flying, you should plan to arrive at Jacksonville International Airport (JAX) between 9:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. on Monday, July 24. You will be met by C.O.P.S. and law enforcement representatives at the airport and transported to Epworth By The Sea by bus once everyone has arrived. You will be transported back to the Jacksonville International Airport on Friday, July 28, by 11:30 a.m. Please be sure your return flight is after 12:00 p.m. to allow time for check-in and security checks.

If you are driving, you will need to plan to arrive at Epworth By The Sea by 5:00 p.m. on Monday, July 24, and stay through breakfast on Friday, July 28. **Meals and activities are planned**; **no late arrivals or early departures please.**

What is the cost of the camp?


