Dear Summer Camp Counselor Applicant,

Thank you so much for your interest in serving as a counselor for this year's Middle School Summer Camp! We are excited to offer this leadership team as an opportunity to serve our 6th-8th grade students and for you to grow in your personal relationship with the Lord. While the actual Summer Camp will be taking place in June of 2026, we will be hosting a series of counselor training meetings as well as small group formation gatherings and a Counselor Retreat Day to ensure that our team is ready to help lead our middle school students.

It is our goal for our Counselors to provide an example of witness and service for all of the middle school students that will be attending camp. For this reason, we will be accepting around 5-6 (depending on how many middle school students sign up) current sophomores, juniors, and seniors to help us. Before you get started with your application process, we want to share with you a bit about what it means to be a Camp Counselor so that you know what you're getting yourself into. Here are some things you can expect:

1. To go deeper in your relationship with Christ and discover more fully what living as a disciple of Jesus means.
2. An opportunity to grow in relationship with one another and other Catholic teens from around the diocese.
3. Meetings/retreat days full of Christ-centered training, vibrant prayer, and small group discussions.
4. A week of living and leading in a fun, upbeat, faith-filled Summer Camp environment!

Specifically we need you to commit to:

1. Refraining from inappropriate language, rude or sexual comments, and swearing.
2. Refraining from the use of alcohol, drugs, or tobacco.
3. Obey all directions of youth ministers and other adult volunteers.
4. Fundraising the full cost of Summer Camp (\$475) by the end of May 2026.
5. Attending the Counselor Trainings, Fundraising Days (as needed), Weekly Formation Groups, the Counselor Retreat Day, as well as the actual Summer Camp.

Let's pause for a moment, before you keep going we wanted to give you a chance to review the specific dates/times we will be asking you to commit to. Attendance at all of the following events is mandatory.

Please keep in mind, before continuing in the application process, that inability to attend our training events impacts the Counselor team as well as our campers. If you are unable to attend a majority of the following events, joining the Counselor Team for this summer may not be for you.
