



- ·Cozy 14(c) workshop environment provides a safe, welcoming, and self-paced workplace for those with disabilities.
- ·VSW coordinates with local businesses to create meaningful work tasks such as packaging, labeling, and medical supply prep.
- ·Most importantly, the shelter provides local citizens a place to feel welcome and avoid self-isolation through outings/group activities.
- ·While the employees of the shelter do get paid for their work, VSW relies completely on donations to keep the lights on.


