# FROM THE PASTOR

### To my St. Peter Family,

In some way, I feel I have said all I wanted to say by way of 'thank you' in the flocknote I sent out three weeks ago. I am grateful for these ten months that God has given to me at St. Peter. Through you and your families, Jesus has rejuvenated, resuscitated and healed parts of my heart that were either dead or dying. So thank you for being a safe place that God could be for me, the Divine Physician.

The privilege that I have had in this year has been to watch this parish come ALIVE! Having lost Fr. Bakkelund just six months prior to the arrival of Fr. Browning and seven months prior to my arrival, the parish was in deep grief and sadness. No doubt that some sadness may still remain and in due time the Lord will bring our "tears to rejoicing" as we journey through this passing world, but I have beheld a miracle in this parish: God has brought you resurrection!

Yes, the Spirit of God is alive in this place. And as St. Paul says, "We move from glory to glory!" This is for me and for you. On this beautiful Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity, we are reminded of the word to describe our Triune God: Perichoresis. This word is translated to "Divine Dance". The Father and the Son are in an eternal divine dance of love and the Spirit is that love. You and I, beloved, by the grace of our baptism are swept up into that divine dance; no longer sitting along the side of the school gym but rather immersed in the dynamic and radiant love of God. And this dance brings us to life! Thank you for this short while, letting me join you in this divine dance of God's love.

It is fitting then that my last prayer corner is on this Solemnity and that we give praise to our Triune God together for all the blessings He has given us, He is giving us, and the blessings that are still to come. So I ask you to pray this prayer five times each day this week in gratitude for all of God's blessings in your life and in this parish.

#### Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, I adore thee.

I love you all and will miss you dearly. I will continue to pray for you. Please pray for me and my soon to be parishes.




