

# The Still Untitled Bulletin Thingy

Hello St. Peter's Family,

In following after Fr. Grismer and his weekly bulletin articles I wanted to do something to inspire a greater culture of prayer, and as an amateur artist, wanted to also do something related to art and beauty. Well, as Fr. Bakkelund would say: "We're a both/and religion." So, here's a bulletin column on both prayer and art.

I guess my vision for this is that I would either share art that I have made or am working on, (or just art that I like) and talk about either what I was thinking and praying through while making it or what can spiritually gleamed from it if I am using somebody else's. So, for this week I did an image of our patron, St. Peter. I know that the feast of Sts. Peter and Paul was last weekend, but I wasn't able to finish this in time for that occasion, so here it is now! This was an image that was drawn by me digitally. As you probably saw with my ordination holy card, I often like to use a monochromatic style. (mostly because figuring out what are good colors to use and breaking everything up is just a lot of work and I am still learning how color theory works). So that is what I did here.

I wanted to portray Peter journeying out on mission, so I opted to portray in in a profile view going right to left. I played around with the lighting a lot and was going for a late evening, or early morning scenario to show he was was either just leaving for or just arriving at wherever he was going. I also thought it would be apt to portray him holding the keys of heaven and earth that Christ had given him. When I have prayed through the various scriptures involving Peter, I often see him as someone who becomes very impulsive and headstrong in the heat of the moment, but in the quiet moments by himself see him as someone who often second guesses those impulsive decisions (especially since Christ had to correct him on more than one occasion). Therefore, in his expression I wanted him to be looking at the keys. Reflecting with a sort of awe and reverence at the great responsibility and authority that those keys

represent. But also, I wanted his face to subtly portray that probable wrestling and self-doubt. One that bears the questioned expressions of: "What am I even supposed to do with these?", and "Will I be able to use these worthily and wisely?" In my short time as a priest, I have often found that the Holy Spirit is not a fan of rehearsals and test drives. In a seemingly paradoxical way, the Spirit teaches us what our gifts are for and how to use them, as we use them. And this is something that the Peter of this image is about to experience. Relying on the Holy Spirit he is going to discover what Christ intended his Rock to be as he goes on this great mission.
