# Dear St. Peter Family,

This weekend, we will have the Annual Mission Appeal in our parish. Fr. Fr. Tommy Kattikanayil MSFS from the missionaries of St. Francis de Sales will be the speaker for this appeal. In the homily he will speak about their mission work mainly in India and several African countries. The congregation of the Missionaries of St. Francis de Sales was founded in Annecy, France in 1837 as missionaries. They are now globally present in 29 counties with membership of more than 1200 priests. The missionaries work among the poor, disadvantaged, marginalized, and illiterate through children's homes, orphanages and schools. More than 2500 economically poor, semi orphan or orphan children are cared for and educated in their 60 children's homes both in India and Africa. Empowering of poor and voiceless women also is one of our priorities. They also need funds for the seminarians' education. There are about two hundred seminarians in different stages of formation in India and Africa. So, they ask your generous donations to continue the good work of the missionaries.

There will be a second collection after the prayer after communion for the mission. Thank you for your generosity!

We are excited for Totus Tuus July 13-18. Evening sessions for grades 7-12 from 7-9:15 PM Sunday-Thursday and Day Camp for grades 1-6 from 9 AM-2:15 PM Monday-Friday. It is a week of vibrant catechesis, witness, and joy that brings the faith alive for our children and teens. Thank you to Nicole, Fr. This week I decided to do a sketch of our new current holy father; Pope Leo XVI. I have done drawings of various popes over the years, and they have always been good practice for drawingnlikeness. One of the biggest things I've learned in terms of making sure the end drawing actually looks like the person I am trying to draw is that it isn't entirely about drawing the particular features correctly but more about putting them in the right place. The eyes, mouth, nose, ears, etc, you draw could be just loose undefined sketchy squiggles, but as long as those squiggles are the right size and in the right place and the right distance from each other proportionally they will begin to resemble the specific person you are trying to draw. So, likeness less about the particular features and more about the relationship of those features with one another. I'm sure there is some way to spiritualize this. Something...something...the likeness of Christ in his Church is seen in

the relationship of his members with Himself and one another...something...something. But there is something very true about human beings only truly being understood, not in isolation, but in relationship, with God first and foremost and with others.

Anyway, here is the drawing of Pope Leo. I did it with just one mechanical pencil. I've always

struggled with trying to get proportions (and hence likeness) correct but I think I did an ok job on that front overall, though there is probably still some proportional wonkiness.

Please keep our Holy Father in your prayers as he continues to enter into his new role. (And don't forget to pray for me as well!) Well...that's all I got. Peace!






