# Dear St. Peter Family,

#### **The One Thing Necessary**

In today's Gospel (Luke 10:38-42), Jesus enters the home of Martha and Mary. While Martha busies herself with the details of hospitality, Mary sits at His feet and listens. When Martha appeals to Jesus to have Mary help her, He gently responds:

# "Martha, Martha, you are anxious and worried about many things. There is need of only one thing."

Jesus does not rebuke Martha for her service—He honors her desire to care for others. But He points to something more profound. Mary has chosen the "better part": the contemplative gaze upon Christ, which must be the heart of all our activity. Without this center, our service becomes anxious, fragmented, and burdensome.

#### Pope Benedict XVI once said:

"The most important thing is not what we do, but what we let God do in us...
Only if we let ourselves be formed by God, will we be able to form others."
This is precisely what Mary models—she allows herself to be formed by the Word of God, by simply being present to Him.

Pope Francis also reminds us of the danger of "pastoral activism" when it's not rooted in Christ:

"Many pastoral workers fall prey to burnout... because they mistake their identity with what they do. But we are not the sum of our works; we are beloved children of the Father." (Let us not forget this during busy times!)

This Gospel serves as a reminder that our **identity precedes our actions**. Our busyness does not define us, but rather our relationship with Jesus. Time with Him is not a luxury—it is **the one thing necessary**.

#### This week, ask Jesus:

- To help you set aside some time to sit at the feet of Jesus each day?
- To help your activity flow from a place of prayer and communion with Him?
- To help you do all things, from big to small, out of love for Him?

Let us, like Mary, choose the better part—one that cannot be taken from us. May all our "Martha work" be rooted in "Mary moments," and may our hearts find peace in the presence of Christ.

He was a priest and military chaplain during the Korean war. On the battlefields he would offer Mass, pray with and minister to his men in the foxholes and by his unassuming witness provided hope and nourishment to the arid and bleak atmosphere of war.

I present this firstly as an encouragement to pray for the men who are already priests that they

may be courageous and offer their ministry in the spirit of sacrifice and secondly, to pray that the men whom God desires to call to the priesthood may be filled with that same courage. And lastly to pray for all military veterans as well!

This image was done by me a few months ago actually. It was drawn in charcoal and was actually the second version. I had done an initial sketch of Kapaun that went pretty horrendously and I felt I had to redo it and try again. I think I was able to iron out a lot of the things that went wrong the first time. Better proportions, better values, better line work, better ingredients, better pizza, Papa John's. I love the way charcoal lies on paper, it and almost like drawing with ash and allows you to get very dark, rich values. Lastly, in a similar vein to my holy card I also added on some digital finishing touches. Anyway, that's all I got...














# **OUR MINISTRIES**




