

Dear St. Peter Family,

This Sunday's readings remind us of the power, persistence, and intimacy of prayer. In the Gospel, the disciples ask Jesus, "Lord, teach us to pray." In response, Jesus gives them—and us—the Lord's Prayer, a prayer that is not just a formula but a pattern of trusting surrender to our Heavenly Father.

In the first reading, we see Abraham boldly interceding with God for the people of Sodom. It's a beautiful and even surprising exchange. Abraham speaks with God as one might speak with a friend—reverent, yes, but persistent and trusting. And God listens. Abraham teaches us that intercessory prayer flows from a heart that believes in God's justice and mercy.

Jesus affirms that same trust in the Father in today's Gospel. He encourages us to ask, seek, and knock—not because God needs convincing, but because our hearts are changed in the asking. God is not reluctant to bless us. As Jesus says, "How much more will the Father in heaven give the Holy Spirit to those who ask him?"

That last line is especially important. So often we pray for specific things, but Jesus teaches us that the greatest gift the Father wants to give us is Himself—His Spirit, His presence, His love. Our prayer is not just about getting things from God; it's about growing in relationship with Him.

Let's continue to encourage one another to be people of prayer—persistent, trusting, and open to receiving the Holy Spirit in new ways each day. Whether we pray with our families, in the silence of our hearts, or in the liturgy of the Church, let's never lose sight of this truth: we are speaking to a Father who delights in His children.

May God bless you and your loved ones this week.

BEAUTY'S ARROW - PULCHRITUDO VULNERA

The contemplation of beauty

In 2002, then Cardinal Ratzinger (future Pope Benedict XVI) sent a message to the Communion and Liberation meeting at Rimini titled, "The Feeling of Things, the Contemplation of Beauty" In this address he quoted Byzantine theologian Nicholas Cabasilas who describes the relationship between beauty and desire. "When men have a longing so great that it surpasses human nature... it is the Bridgroom who has smitten them with this longing. It is he who has sent a ray of his beauty into their eyes. The greatness of the wound already shows the arrow which has struck home, the longing indicates who has inflicted the wound."

Ratzinger summarizes this reality in the next line, "The beautiful wounds, but this is exactly how it summons man to his final destiny." I have always loved this line because it describes beauty as something more than just pointless aesthetic pleasantness. Because true beauty is more than that. It affects us, it wounds us because it awakens the deepest longing of our hearts to what they ultimately long for, for that which transcends the visible, for God, who is the author of all beauty. Beauty is not pointless, nor is it safe. As Bishop Barron regularly points out, it is beauty that will save the world and draw this generation to Christ. Truth and goodness in our modern world have become relativized and thus, easily ignored. But beauty is something else. It has an edge, it cuts past all walls and barriers, and it wounds. It is impossible to ignore. I want this article series to be a continuation of what Cardinal Ratzinger started, to be a contemplation of beauty. So that our hearts may be wounded by its arrow and awakened to our longing for its archer. To Christ.

Since it was his reflection that inspired the name for this spot, this weeks image is of Cardinal Ratzinger drawn in graphite.

RESPECT LIFE MINISTRY

A victory for life was won June 26, when the Supreme Court decided 6-3 that states can determine whether or not they will fund abortions in the case *Medina v. Planned Parenthood South Atlantic*. The ruling backed South Carolina's move to take Planned Parenthood off the state's Medicaid program. At its annual meeting, the **American Medical Association (AMA) House of Delegates (HOD)** overwhelmingly rejected an attempt to change AMA policy and, in doing so, re-affirmed its longstanding policy in opposition to assisted suicide. It also approved a Board of Trustees report which rejected attempts to change the longstanding and clear terminology "physician assisted suicide" in AMA policy. The 2025 Board of Trustees report states that "the profession of medicine should not support the legalization or practice of physician assisted suicide or see it as part of a physician's role." - *Patients Rights Action Fund*


