Dear St. Peter Family,

On August 4th we celebrate St. John Vianney, patron saint of parish priests. He was known for his holiness and zeal for hearing confessions sometimes up to 14 hours a day. Please pray for parish priests, especially Fr. Nooraee and me that we may have greater zeal for making God known and loved. Here is a St. John Vianney's Act of Love prayer:

Arrival

Most people who know me know that I am a film nerd. I have loved watching movies for as long as my eyes have worked. Due to that fact many people will ask me what my favorite movie is, which is a question that I have never really been able to answer. How can I pick just one? So, I usually sidestep the dilemma by giving a rapid-fire spattering of movies I really like. Usually around ten or so films. However, there is one film that is always mentioned pretty early in that burst, 2016's Arrival.

Now can I call Arrival my favorite film ever in a world where *Jurassic Park, The Prestige, The Prince of Egypt, The Empire Strikes Back, The Truman Show, The Passion of the Christ, There Will Be Blood, Signs, and Airplane*! also exist? Probably not. But it had a lasting impact ever since I first saw it. The movie revolves around Amy Adam's character Louise, a renowned linguist, who is called in by the military when several alien ships land on earth. Louise is tasked with trying to understand the alien's language in order to ask them why they came in the first place. In the nature of avoiding spoilers, I won't say too much but I will say that one of the films central themes is how communication affects perception. The way in which we communicate with each other (and others communicate with us) affects the way in which we perceive the world around. This could not be truer in prayer. To speak

and hear the words of love in prayer allows us to perceive that love in the world. If we only communicate in the context of hostility, hostility is all we will perceive.

Now did I just use this column to plug one of my favorite films? Perchance. But I think it is a good reminder that we can see goodness truth and beauty in almost everything, including movies. So this weeks drawing is inspired by Arrival. If you haven't seen it, I recommend it. Well.. that's all I got.

RESPECT LIFE MINISTRY

A victory for life was won June 26, when the Supreme Court decided 6-3 that states can determine whether or not they will fund abortions in the case Medina v. Planned Parenthood South Atlantic. The ruling backed South Carolina's move to take Planned Parenthood off the state's Medicaid program. At its annual meeting, the **American Medical Association (AMA) House of Delegates (HOD)** overwhelmingly rejected an attempt to change AMA policy and, in doing so, re-affirmed its longstanding policy in opposition to assisted suicide. It also approved a Board of Trustees report which rejected attempts to change the longstanding and clear terminology "physician assisted suicide" in AMA policy. The 2025 Board of Trustees report states that "the profession of medicine should not support the legalization or practice of physician assisted suicide or see it as part of a physician's role." - *Patients Rights Action Fund*






FOX VALLEY CATHOLIC BIBLE STUDY St. Patrick (Crane Rd.) hosts this year!
