

Dear St. Peter Family,

The Solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary Holy Day of Obligation – August 15 Mass Times: Thursday, August 14: 4:30 PM (Vigil) Friday, August 15: 7:00 AM | 8:35 AM | 7:00 PM

Dear St. Peter Family,

Friday, August 15, we celebrate one of the most beautiful and important feasts in the Church's liturgical calendar: **the Solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary**, a **Holy Day of Obligation**.

Christians have celebrated the Assumption of Mary since at least the 5th or 6th century. While the New Testament does not explicitly describe Mary's death, the early Church held a strong and consistent tradition that at the end of her earthly life, **Mary was assumed—body and soul—into heavenly glory**. This belief was officially defined as dogma by Pope Pius XII in 1950 in the Apostolic Constitution Munificentissimus Deus, affirming what the faithful had long held: that Mary, the Mother of God, was preserved from corruption and brought into the fullness of life with her Son.

This feast reminds us of Mary's unique role in salvation history and the hope we all share as members of Christ's Body. Where she has gone, we hope to follow. The Assumption is not just about Mary—it is about us, too. It is a sign of **what God desires for all His faithful children**: eternal life in both body and soul. Mary's Assumption is the first fruits of the resurrection promised to all who remain faithful to Christ.

On this holy day, let us honor our Blessed Mother with love and devotion, asking her intercession as we journey toward our eternal destiny. Please make every effort to attend Mass as we rejoice in the triumph of God's grace in Mary's life—and pray for that same grace in our own.

BEAUTY'S ARROW - PULCHRITUDO VULNERA The Cross

When we look to the cross and the suffering and death of Christ, there are many words that probably come to mind. Gruesome, horrifying, painful, etc. "Beautiful" is probably not the word we would immediately throw out and associate with this event... but I am going to anyway.

Something I've mentioned in quite a few wedding homilies is that Christ's example on the cross is not simply "a" loving act. It is not one great act standing alongside and among many other expressions of love. It is "the" loving act. It is the summary of love and its peak. Every loving act that we ever have done or could ever do is always in imitation of Christ's sacrifice on the cross. St. Francis De Sales (who is the statue on the far right in our sanctuary) once said that "Mount Calvary

is the academy of love". It is in that offering that Jesus not only bestows his love on us but teaches us how to love.

This week's image is a sketch of the crucifixion. This is the first one in a while I've done digitally. It didn't take very long and probably could have spent more time rendering.

RESPECT LIFE MINISTRY

A victory for life was won June 26, when the Supreme Court decided 6-3 that states can determine whether or not they will fund abortions in the case Medina v. Planned Parenthood South Atlantic. The ruling backed South Carolina's move to take Planned Parenthood off the state's Medicaid program. At its annual meeting, the **American Medical Association (AMA) House of Delegates (HOD)** overwhelmingly rejected an attempt to change AMA policy and, in doing so, re-affirmed its longstanding policy in opposition to assisted suicide. It also approved a Board of Trustees report which rejected attempts to change the longstanding and clear terminology "physician assisted suicide" in AMA policy. The 2025 Board of Trustees report states that "the profession of medicine should not support the legalization or practice of physician assisted suicide or see it as part of a physician's role." - Patients Rights Action Fund




