





RESPECT LIFE MINISTRY

40 DAYS FOR LIFE: September 24 - November 2

St. Peter will be participating in 40 Days for Life. This is the world's largest grassroots movement to end abortion and has been going strong since 2007 with 1,000,000 volunteers, 20,000 churches, and 13,721 campaigns in 71 different countries. By the grace of God, 40 Days for Life has yielded life-saving results around the world

- 25,695 lives have been saved
- 274 abortion workers have quit
- 18 abortion centers have closed

Illinois has some of the most liberal abortion laws in the United States. At 22,000 square feet, the Aurora Planned Parenthood is one of the largest abortion centers in the country.

- an estimated 300-400 babies' lives are lost at the Aurora Planned Parenthood each month
- up to 75% of women will be a 'no show' for their abortion appointment when there are people praying peacefully outside of an abortion clinic.

For many years, St. Peter has supplied prayer volunteers near the Aurora Planned Parenthood on the 3rd Wednesday of the month. No experience or training is needed. You are asked to simply show up and pray peacefully. Trained sidewalk counselors will also be present to interact with abortion minded women.
